<p>Before Reading Activate prior knowledge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "Have you ever...?" • "What do you know about...?" <p>Predict</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preview illustrations/chapter books • Skim and scan • "I think...will happen because..." (start graphic organizer) • Setting • Characters • Problem • Events • Ending • Character feelings 	<p>Before Reading Activate prior knowledge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "What do you think know or think about...?" <p>Predict</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preview illustrations/chapter books • Skim and scan • Predict the following: • What are you wondering about • Use table of contents • Start a graphic organizer, such as a K-W-L chart or Venn diagram. • Write predictions • "I think I will learn...because..."
<p>During Reading Read [silently, chorally, with partners] to find out predictions</p> <p>Question/Clarify</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reread to find a point/word to clarify • Or, reread to ask a question • Teacher circulates and models and asks individuals to predict, summarize, question, or clarify 	<p>During Reading Read [silently, chorally, with partners] to find out predictions</p> <p>Question/Clarify</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reread to find a point/word to clarify • Or, reread to ask a question • Teacher circulates and models and asks individuals to predict, summarize, question, or clarify
<p>After Reading Predict</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return to predictions to confirm or change <p>Question</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take turns modeling, then partners ask questions about the characters, events, theme <p>Clarify</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss/model words or points to clarify and say "I didn't get the part where..., so I..." • Discuss ways to clarify <p>Summarize</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summarize as a group or page by page • Fill in a graphic organizer with setting, characters, problem, events, ending, feelings • Which strategy helped you the most today and why? • Give examples 	<p>After Reading Predict</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return to predictions to confirm or change <p>Question</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Model for students as you question using headings/main ideas • Partners ask questions <p>Clarify</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss/model words or points to clarify and say "I didn't get the part where..., so I..." • Discuss ways to clarify <p>Summarize</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summarize as a group, or page by page with partners • Return to fill in graphic organizer with what was learned • Which strategy helped you the most today and why? • Give examples
