Classroom Procedure

Discipline

1. Be on time to my class. If you are more than five minutes late you will owe me time after school!
2. Be respectful to not only me, but your classmates as well.

4. Every student will be treated with respect and equitably. You are responsible for yourself. Do your own work; don’t worry about anyone else’s in the classroom. If you ever have an issue with a grade you received on a test, quiz, paper or otherwise, do not hesitate to ask me for an explanation.
5. Films/videos are part of my history classes.
