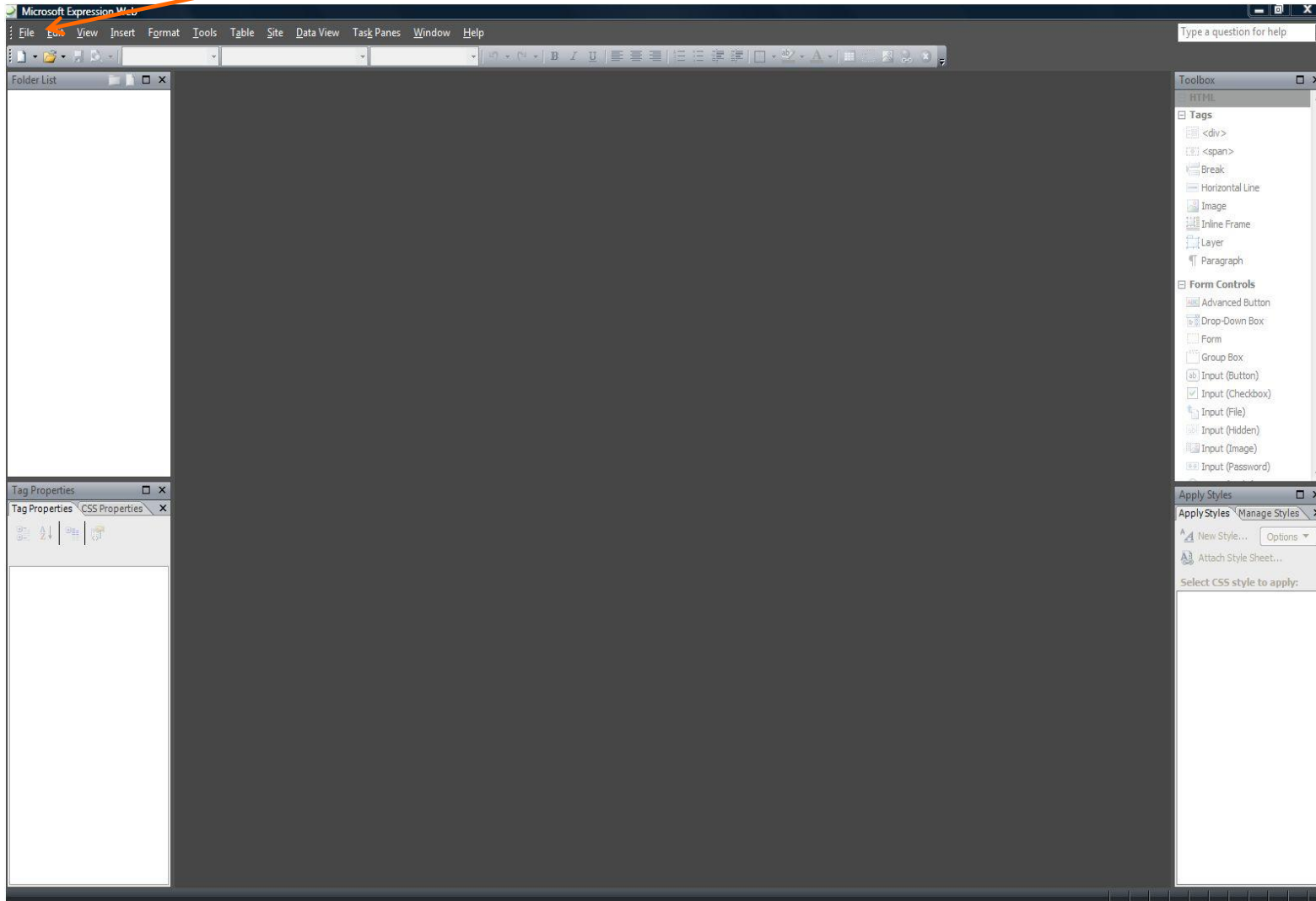


The main page is always index.html or index.htm. Either one will work, but you do need it.

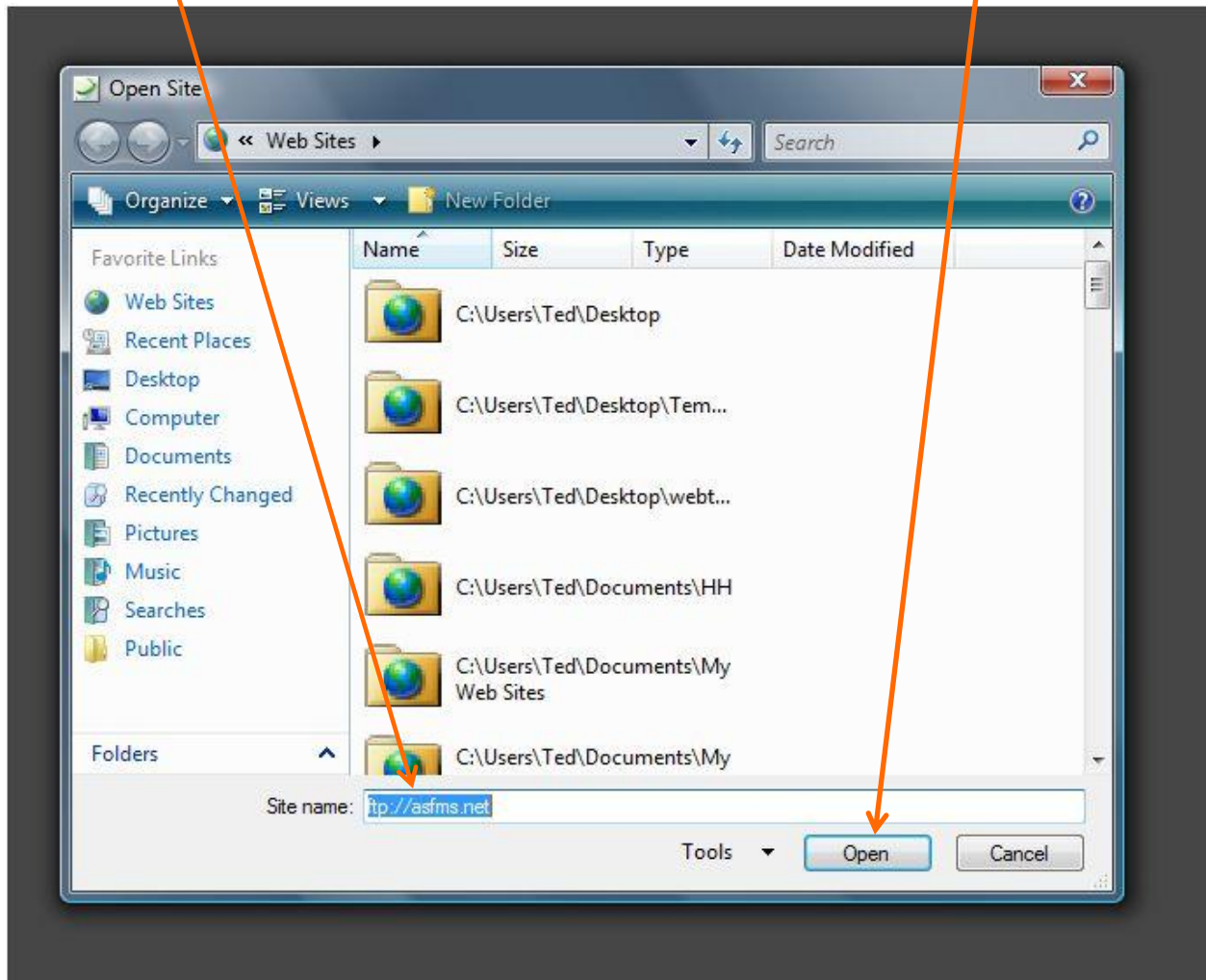

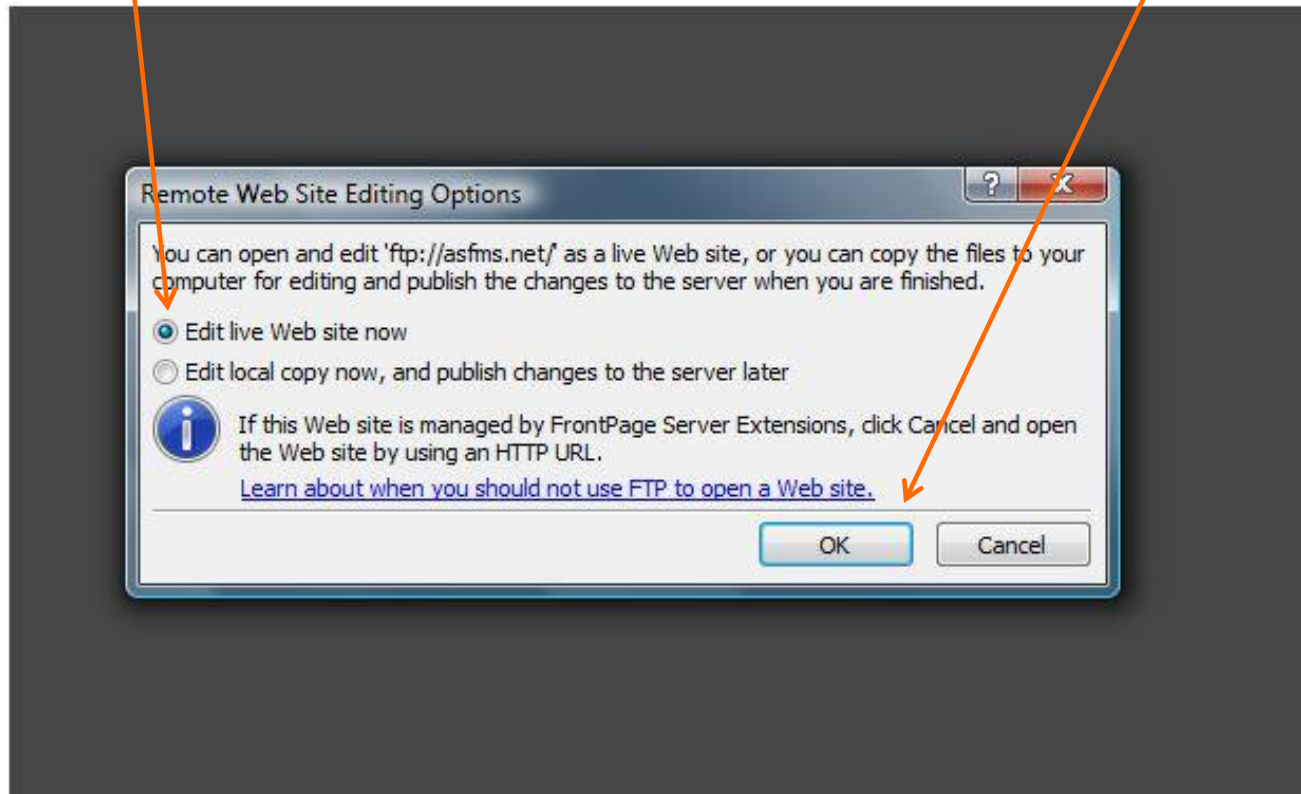
OPEN EXPRESSION WEB AND CLICK “FILE” THEN “OPEN SITE” FROM THE DROP-DOWN MENU.



THIS WINDOW APPEARS. TYPE FTP://ASFMS.NET THEN CLICK “OPEN”



THIS WINDOW APPEARS. IT SHOULD DEFAULT AS “EDIT LIVE WEB SITE NOW.” CLICK “OPEN.”



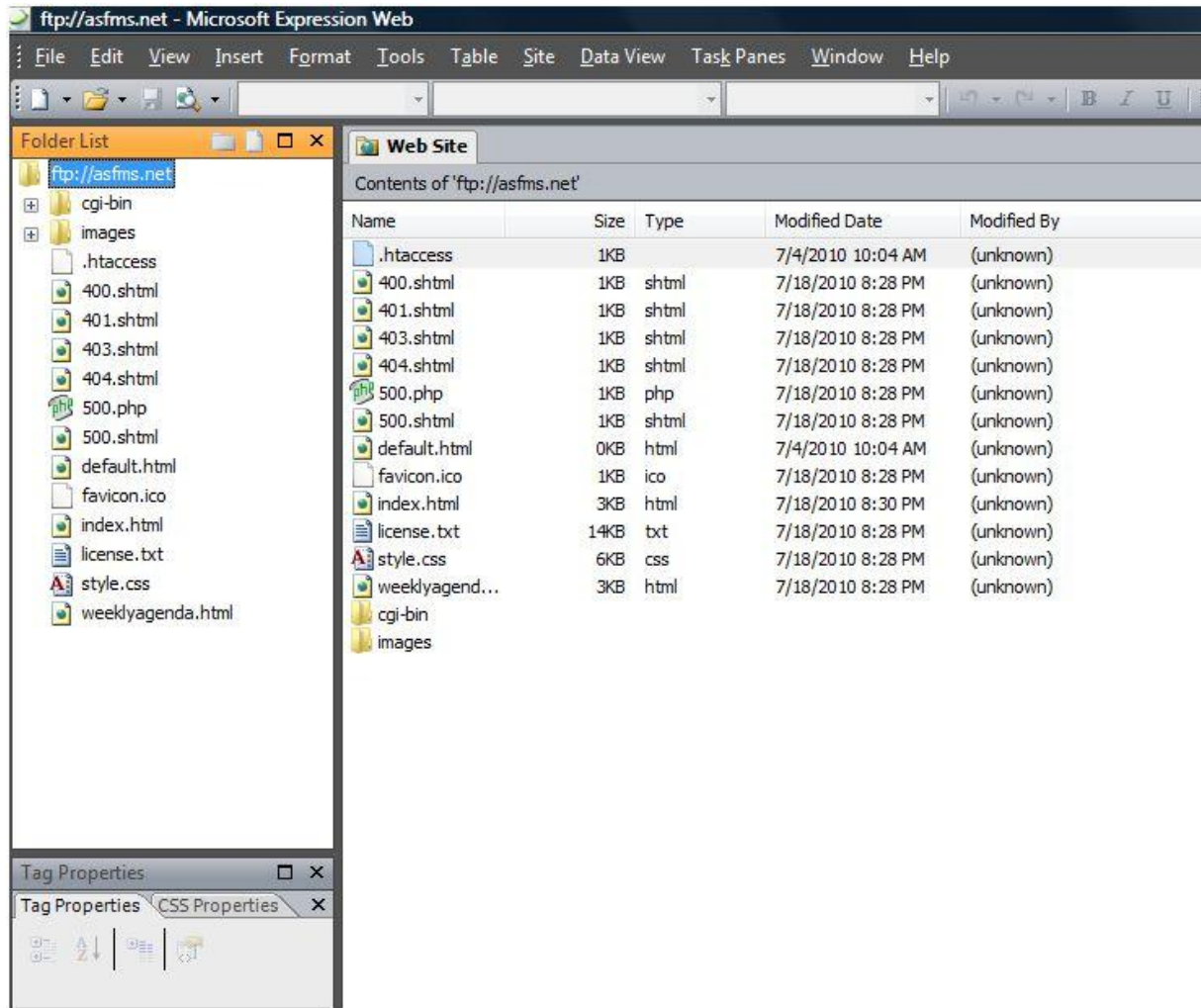
THIS LOGIN WINDOW APPEARS. YOUR USERNAME@ASFMS.NET, THEN YOUR PASSWORD IS WHAT I SENT TO YOU VIA EMAIL.



Click to “Remember my password” if this is your only site...makes things easier.



THE SITE LOADS FROM THE SERVER. IT IS “LIVE” NOW, SO ANY CHANGES YOU MAKE WILL IMMEDIATELY APPEAR ONLINE.



You can double-click a page to open it.



I OPENED THE INDEX OR MAIN PAGE. YOU CAN EDIT RIGHT HERE IF YOU WANT, BUT IT IS BETTER/SAFER TO PUBLISH IT/SAVE IT TO YOUR COMPUTER, THEN EDIT IT. CLICK FILE, THEN “PUBLISH SITE” FROM THE DROP-DOWN MENU.

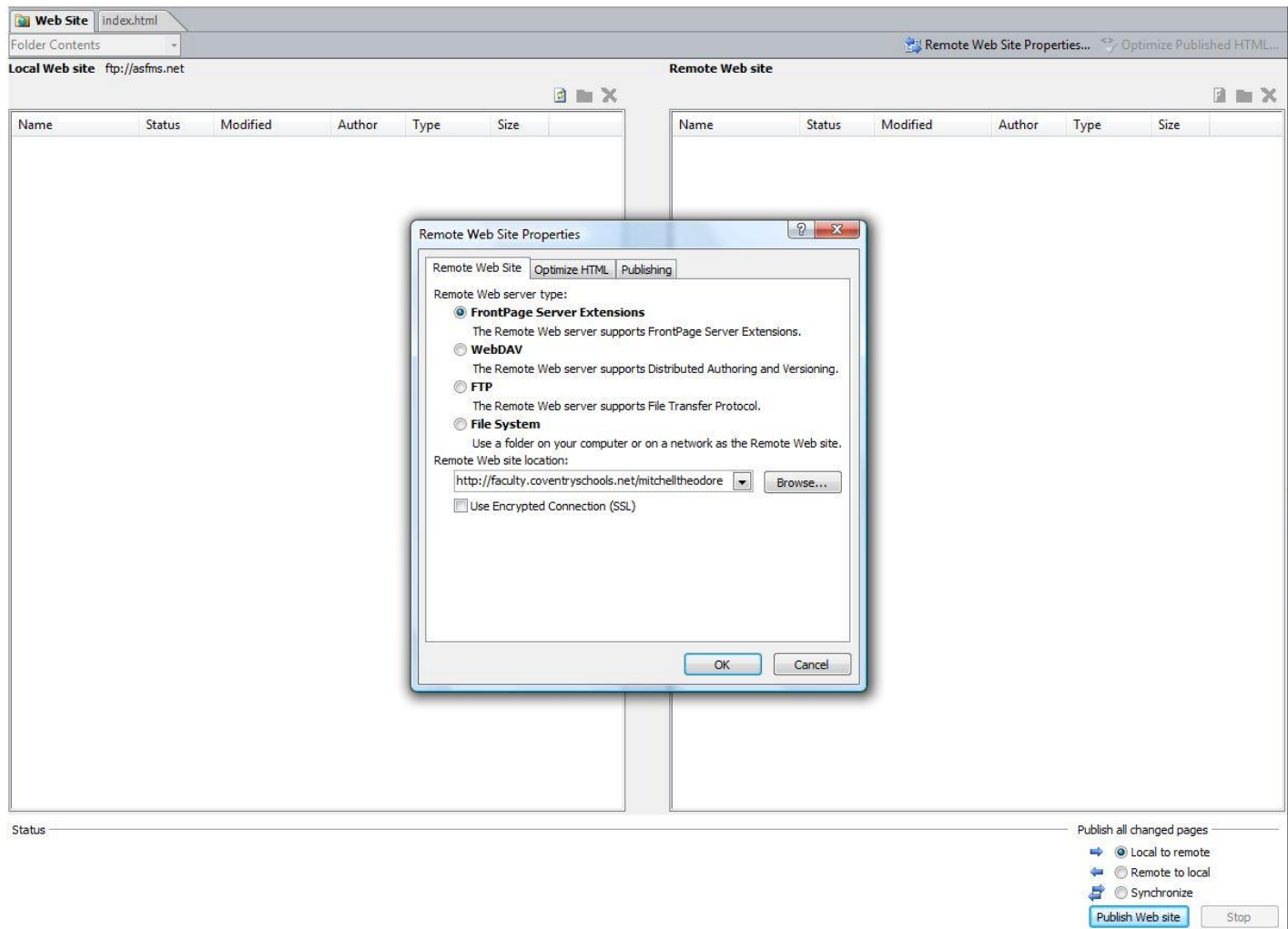

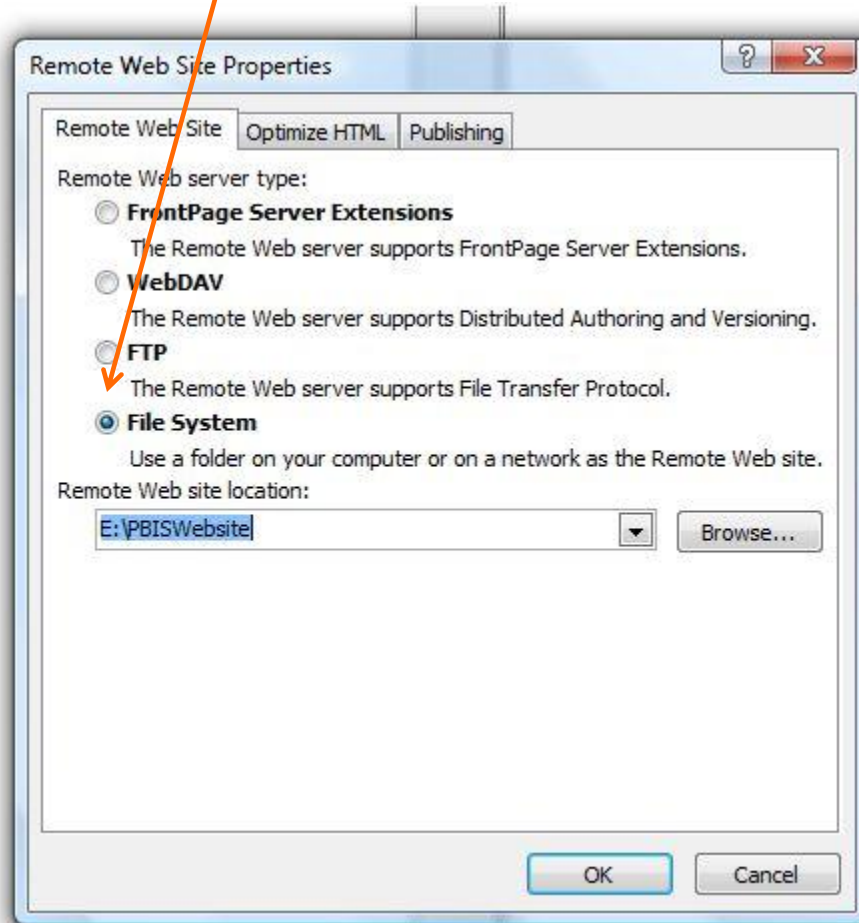

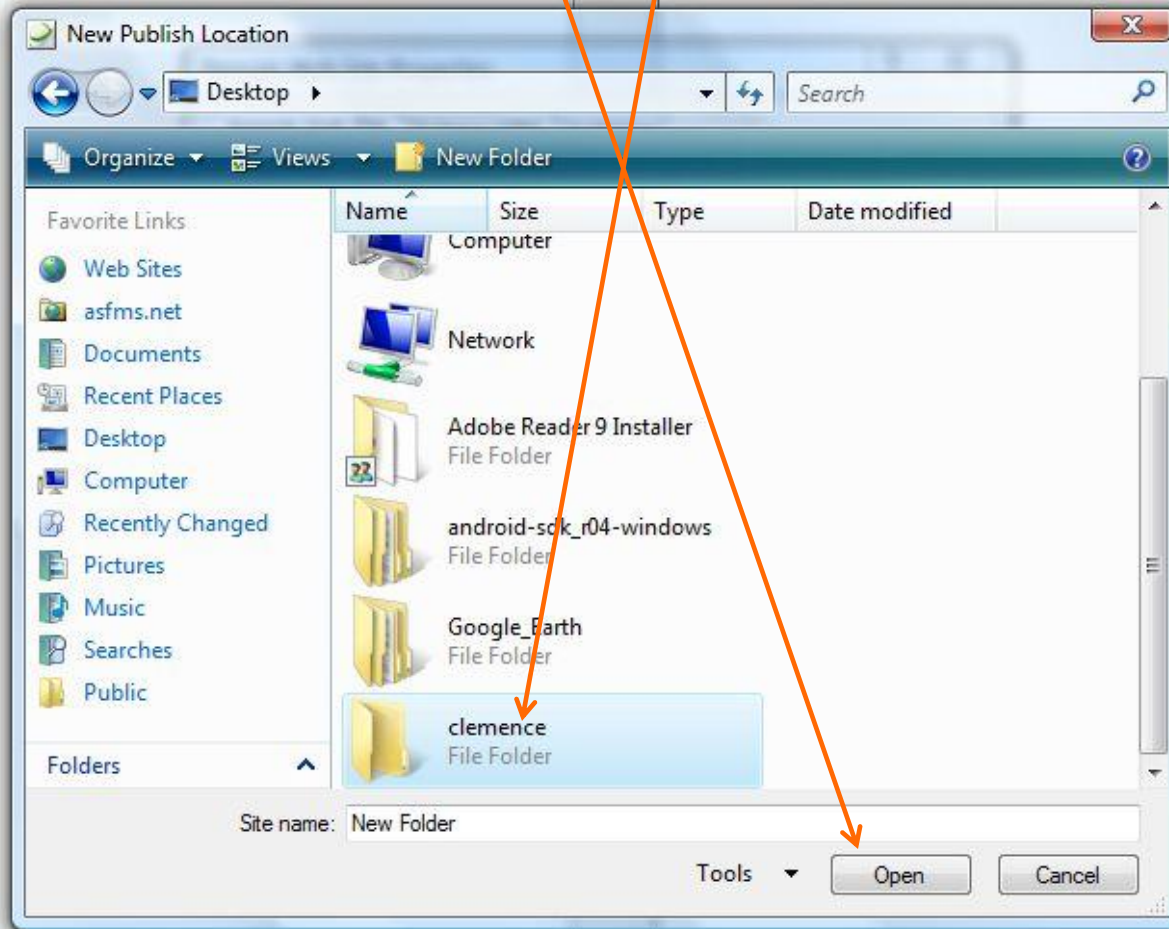
THIS WINDOW APPEARS. YOU NEED TO CHANGE THE “REMOTE SERVER TYPE”



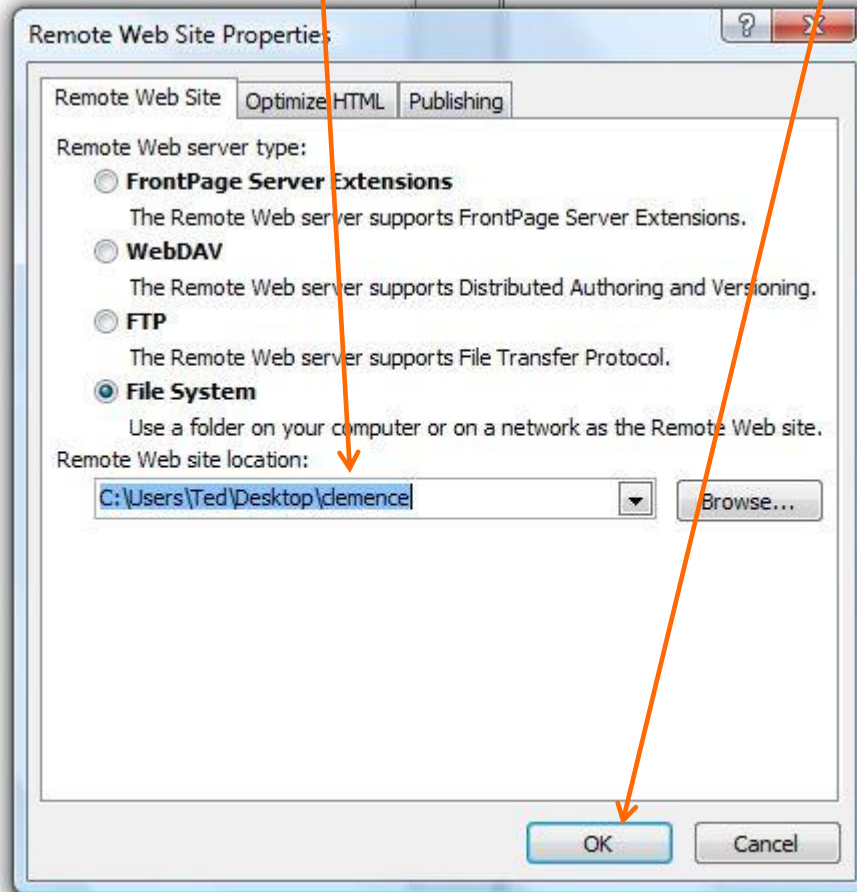

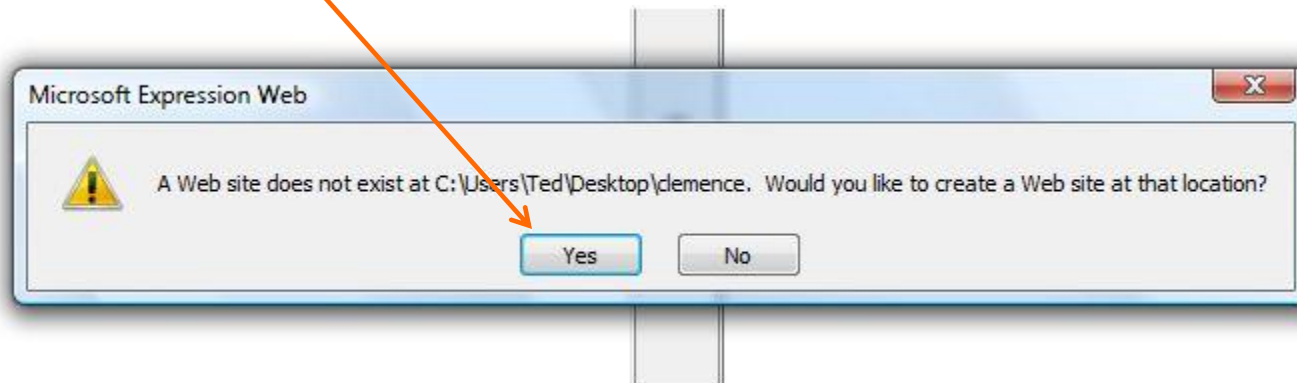

THIS WINDOW APPEARS. THE “REMOTE WEB SITE LOCATION” IS NOW CHANGED TO PUBLISH THE SITE TO THE “CLEMENCE” FOLDER. CLICK “OK”

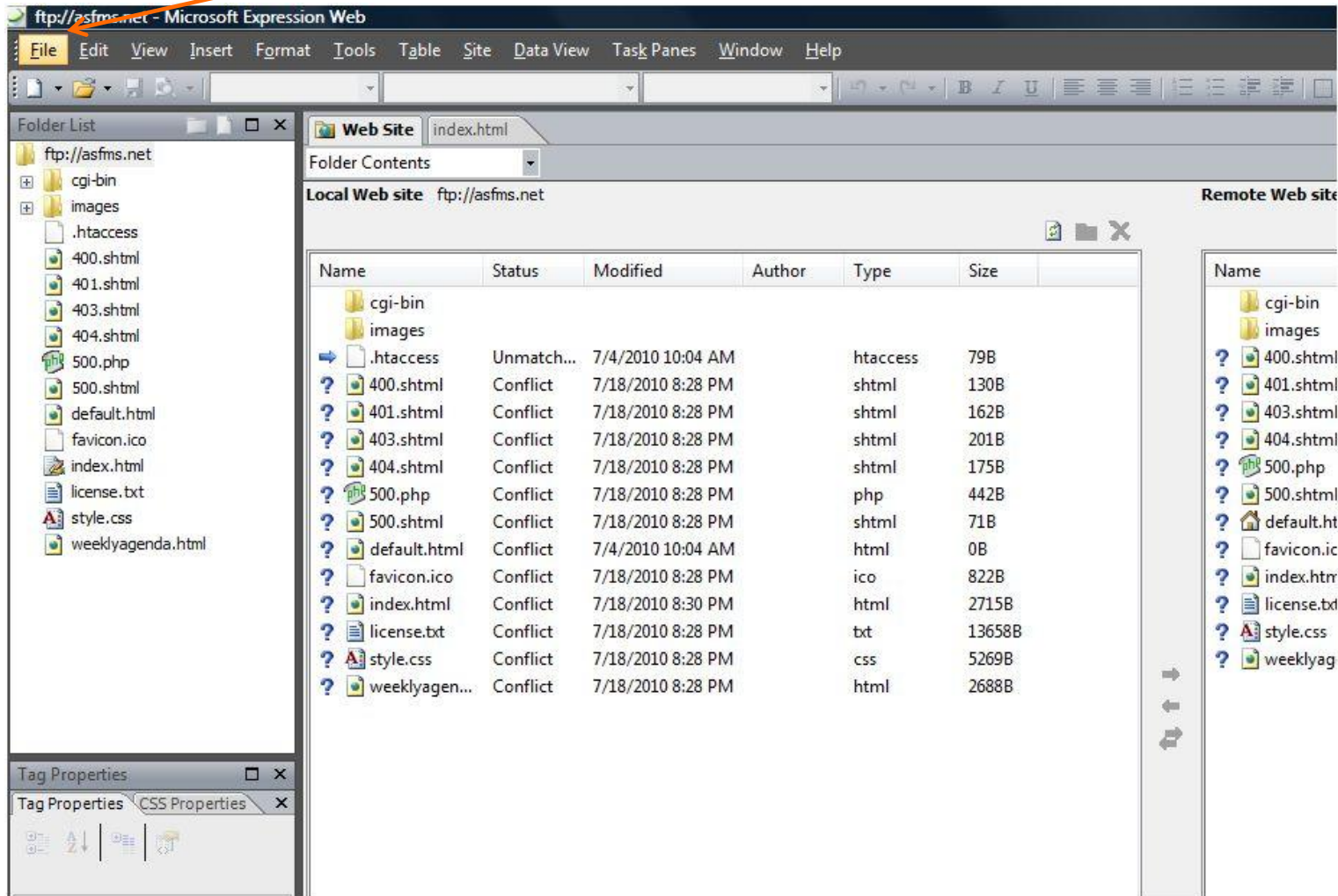

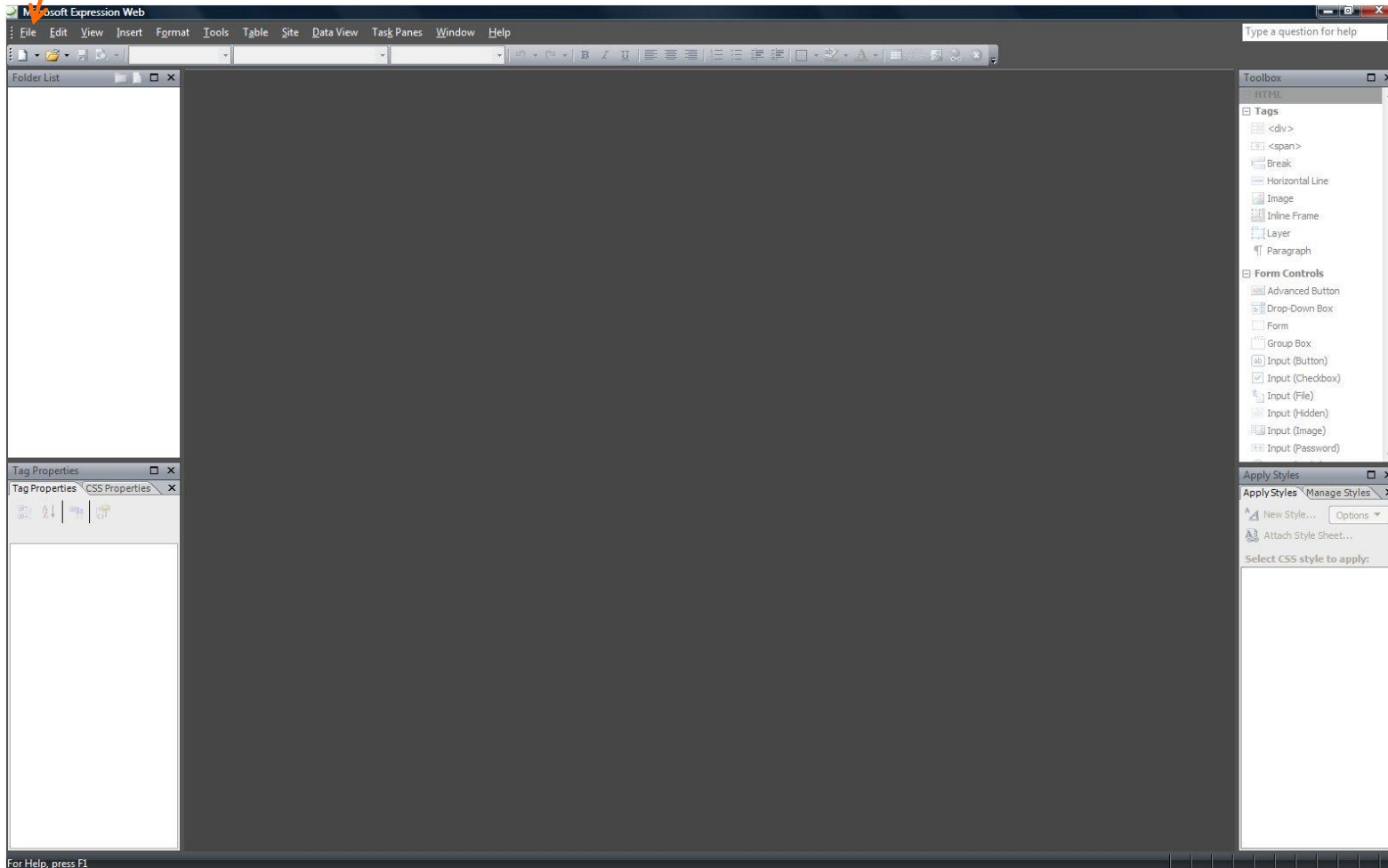

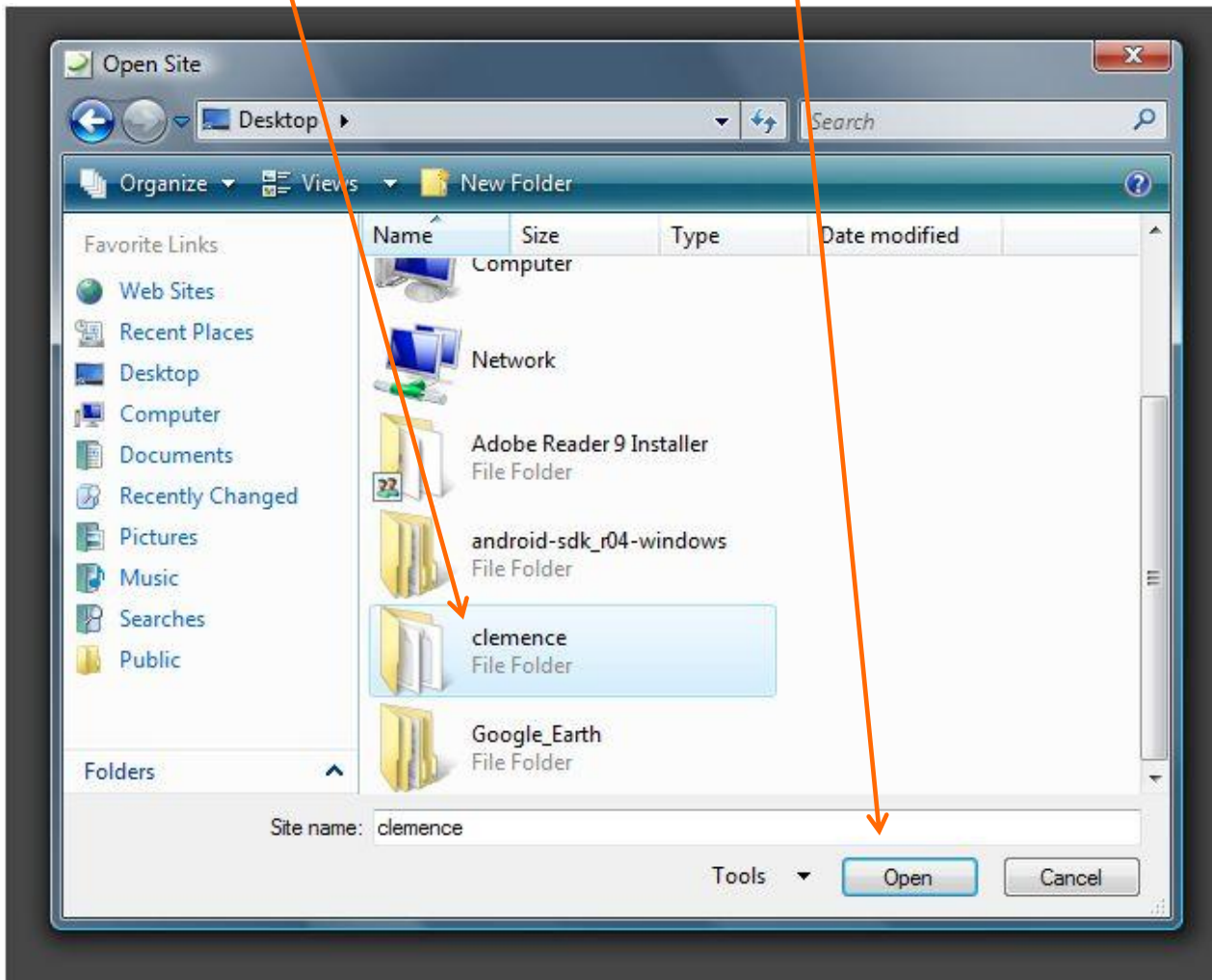
ONCE IT IS DONE, CLICK “FILE” THEN “CLOSE SITE” FROM THE DROP-DOWN MENU.



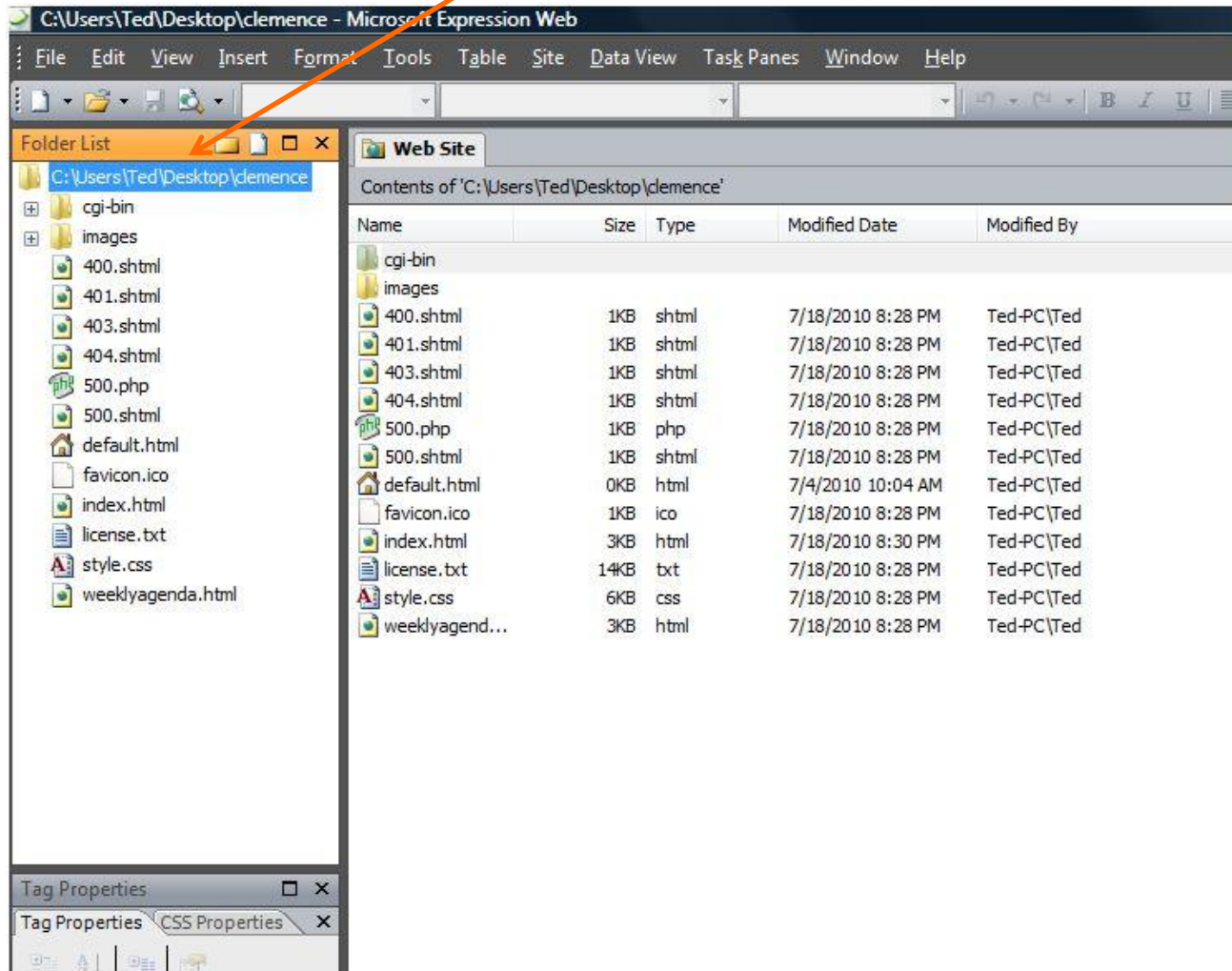
EXPRESSION THEN CLEARS ITSELF. NOW CLICK
“FILE” THEN “OPEN SITE” FROM THE DROP-
DOWN MENU.



THIS WINDOW APPEARS. FIND YOUR SITE FOLDER YOU CREATED. HERE I HAVE THE “CLEMENCE” FOLDER. CLICK “OPEN” UNTIL IT LOADS IN EXPRESSION.



NOW THE SITE IS LOADED ON THE LOCAL COMPUTER, NOT THE SERVER. OPEN ANY PAGE BY DOUBLE-CLICKING ON IT AND EDIT. ONCE YOU ARE DONE, THEN YOU WILL PUBLISH BACK TO THE SERVER.



Editing on your local computer allows you room for error. Any mistake is ONLY seen on your computer, not the website.
