



EDITING LIVE FROM THE SCHOOL'S SERVER

**This is only allowed with Frontpage extensions.
Once these are removed, you won't be able to use
this method.**

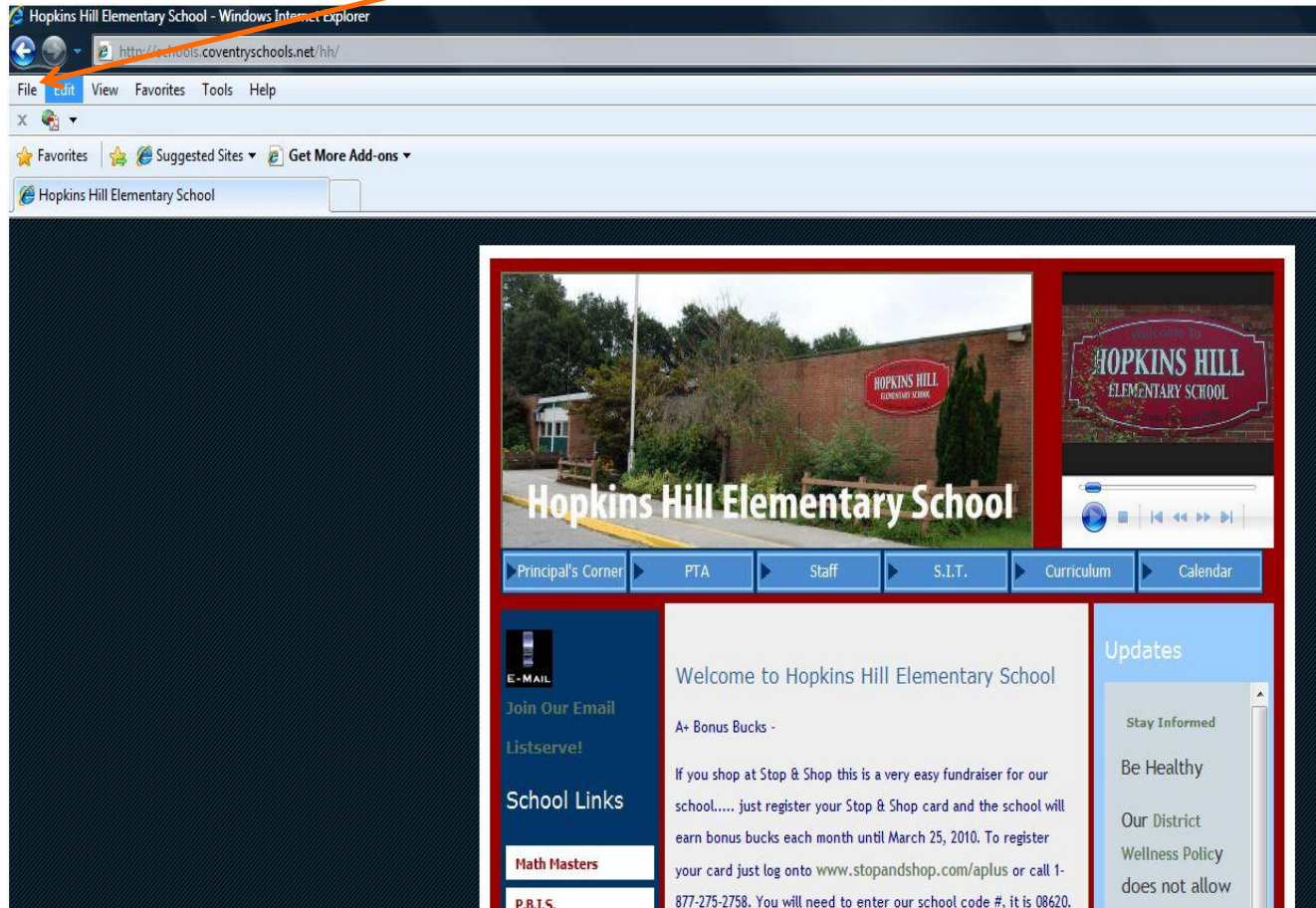
DISCLAIMER:

- Frontpage 2003 was the last version of Frontpage published. Microsoft ended the production.
- Frontpage web software required servers to install Frontpage Extensions (server-side software) in order for many features to work properly.
- Frontpage was great in many ways, but the Extensions inevitably broke down or became corrupted and needed to be re-installed again and again.
- Microsoft does not support this software anymore, so it will NEVER be fixed. This is why we need to get away from using it.



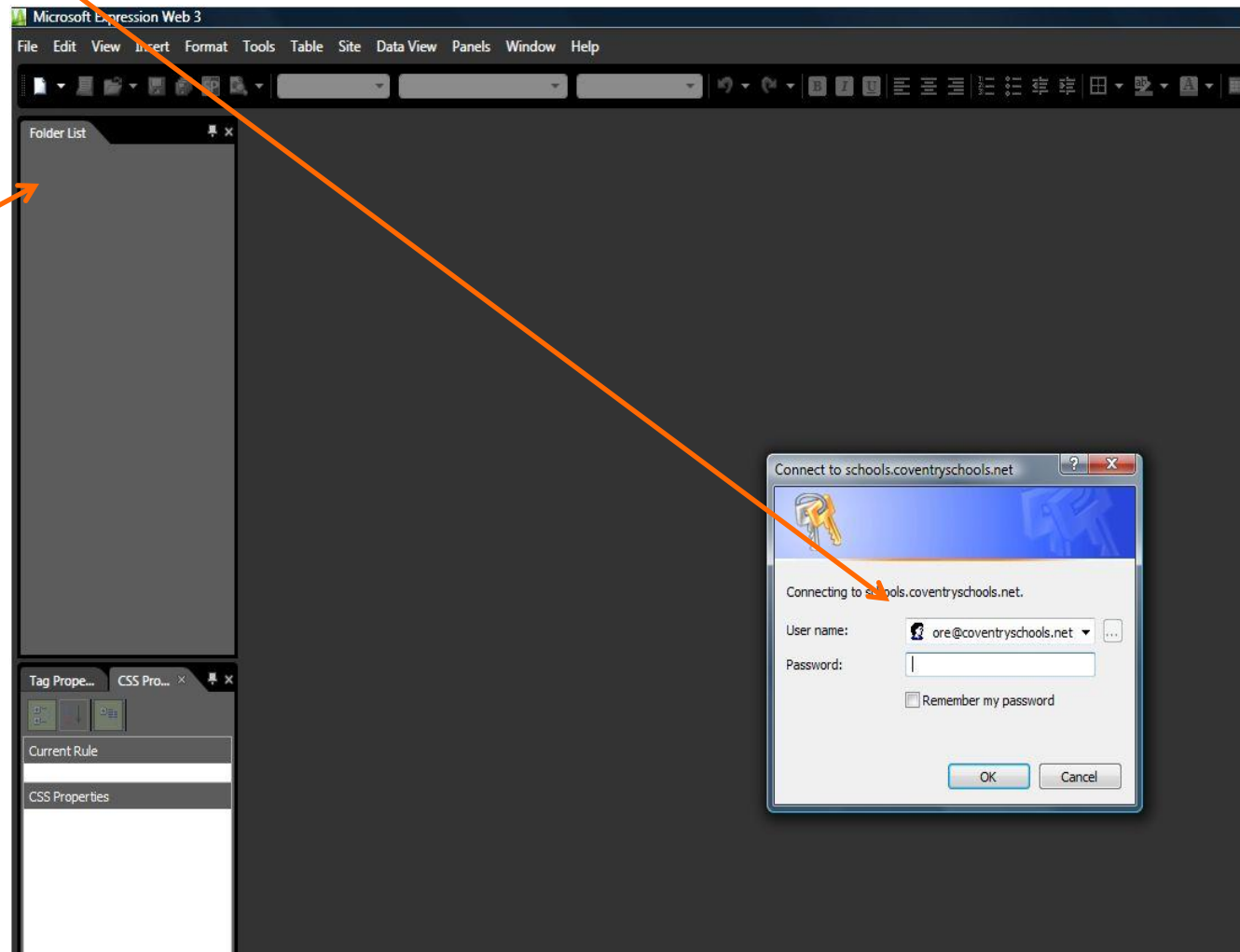
TO EDIT USING THESE “EXTENSIONS,” GO TO YOUR EXISTING WEBPAGE IN INTERNET EXPLORER AND CLICK “FILE” THEN “EDIT WITH EXPRESSION WEB.”

You need to have opened Expression Web once and made it your “Default web editor.” It prompts you automatically. If you haven’t done this, it will say, “Open with Word or Frontpage.. Depending upon your software.



EXPRESSION WEB WILL OPEN THEN PROMPT YOU FOR A USERNAME AND PASSWORD. IF IT DOESN'T PROMPT YOU, THE EXTENSIONS SOFTWARE IS BROKEN. CONTACT JIM MURPHY.

Even if the server extensions are broken, the page will open up, but you won't have a folder list and while you can make any changes to that page, you won't be able to save it to the server... so, you are wasting your time.



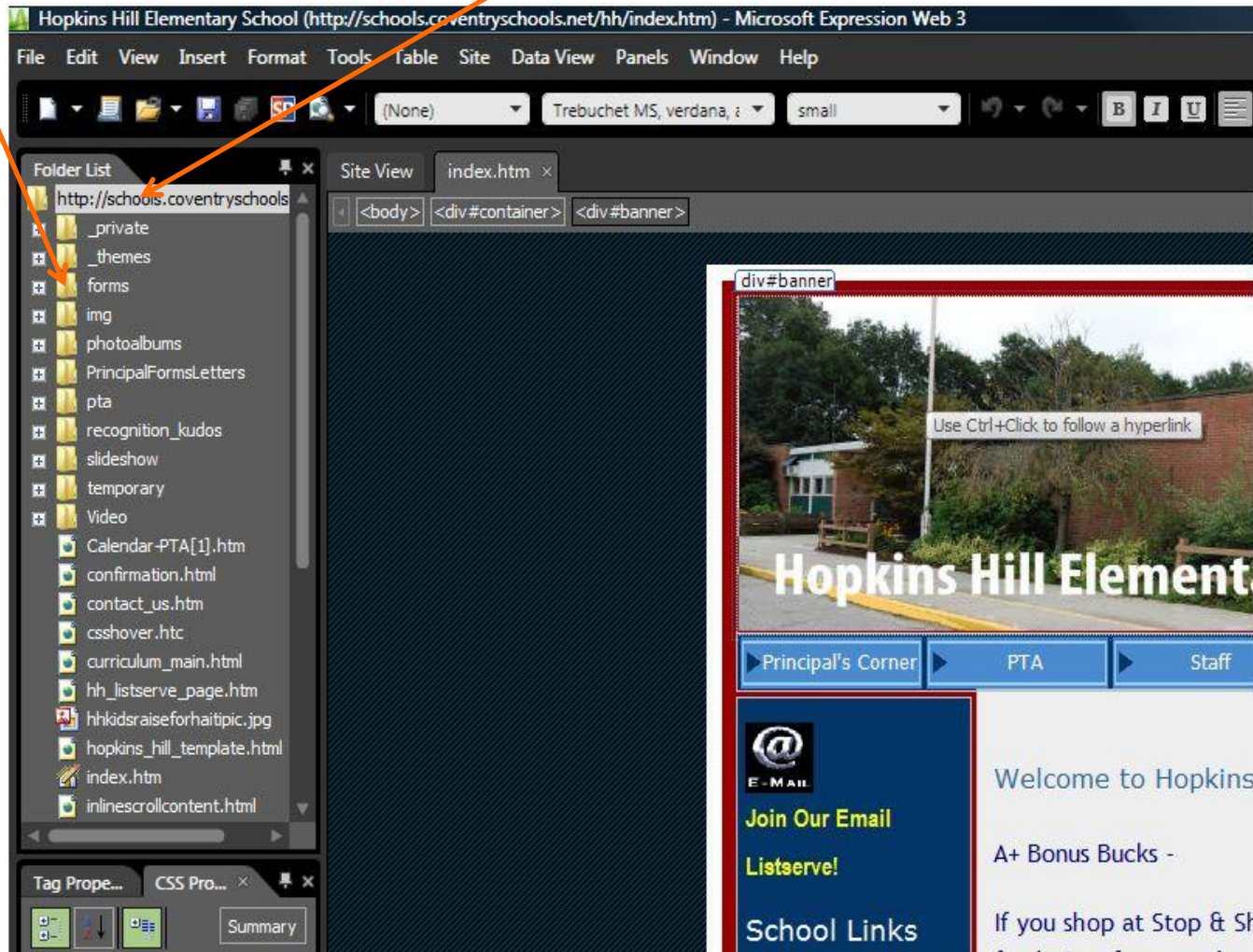
REMEMBER: USERNAME IS YOUR REGULAR USERNAME FOR THE DISTRICT AND YOU HAVE TO ADD “@COVENTRYSCHOOLS.NET” AT THE END OF IT. PASSWORD – YOU SHOULD KNOW THIS.

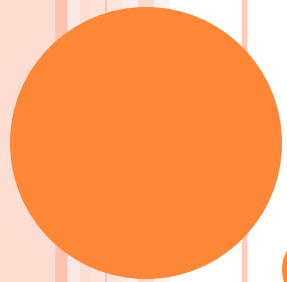
If you are at the middle school, I should have given this info to you. Email if not.



THE SITE IS OPEN. YOU SHOULD SEE THE URL AT THE TOP OF THE FOLDER LIST AND ALL CONTENT WITHIN THE FOLDER UNDERNEATH. EDIT AWAY...*

*Understand that you will be editing live, so all “saves” you make, will immediately appear online. Also, your edits will **ONLY** be saved on the server, nowhere else. This is why it is better to edit on your local hard drive then publish. This way you have it backed up automatically.
