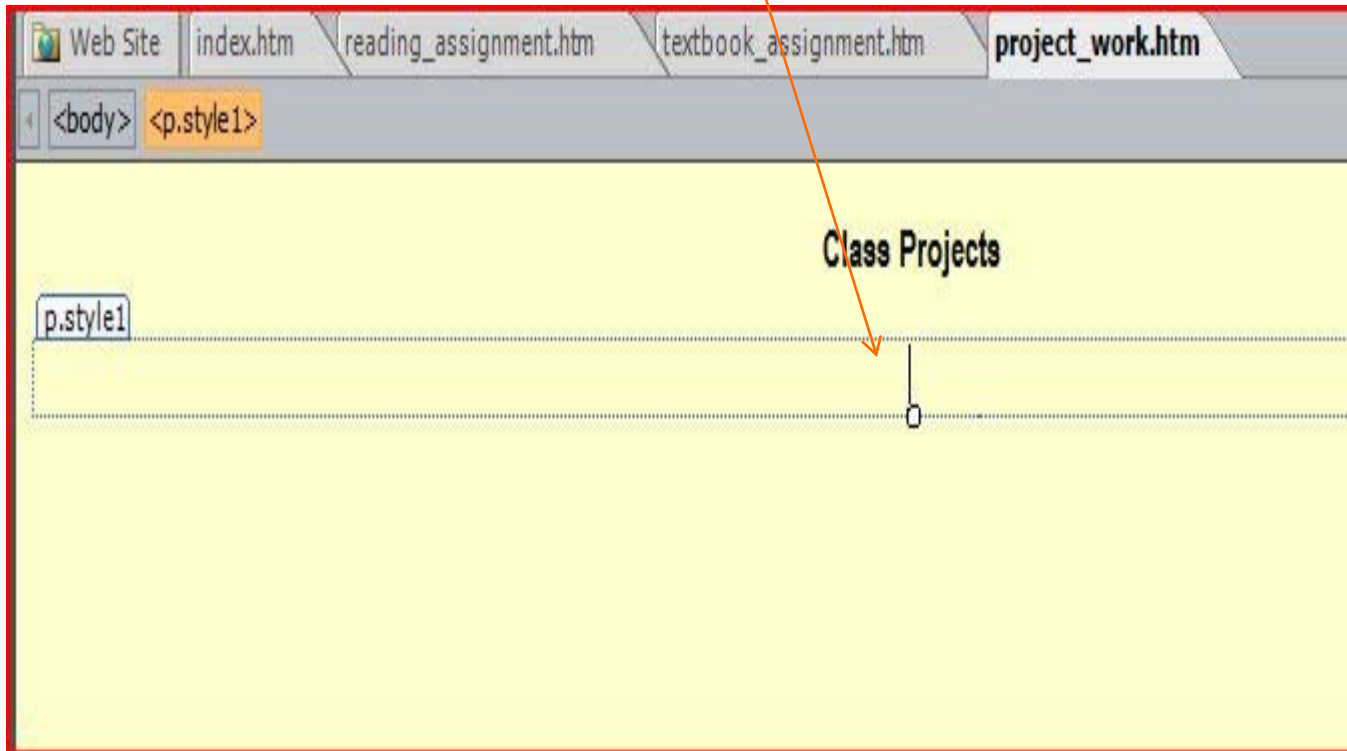


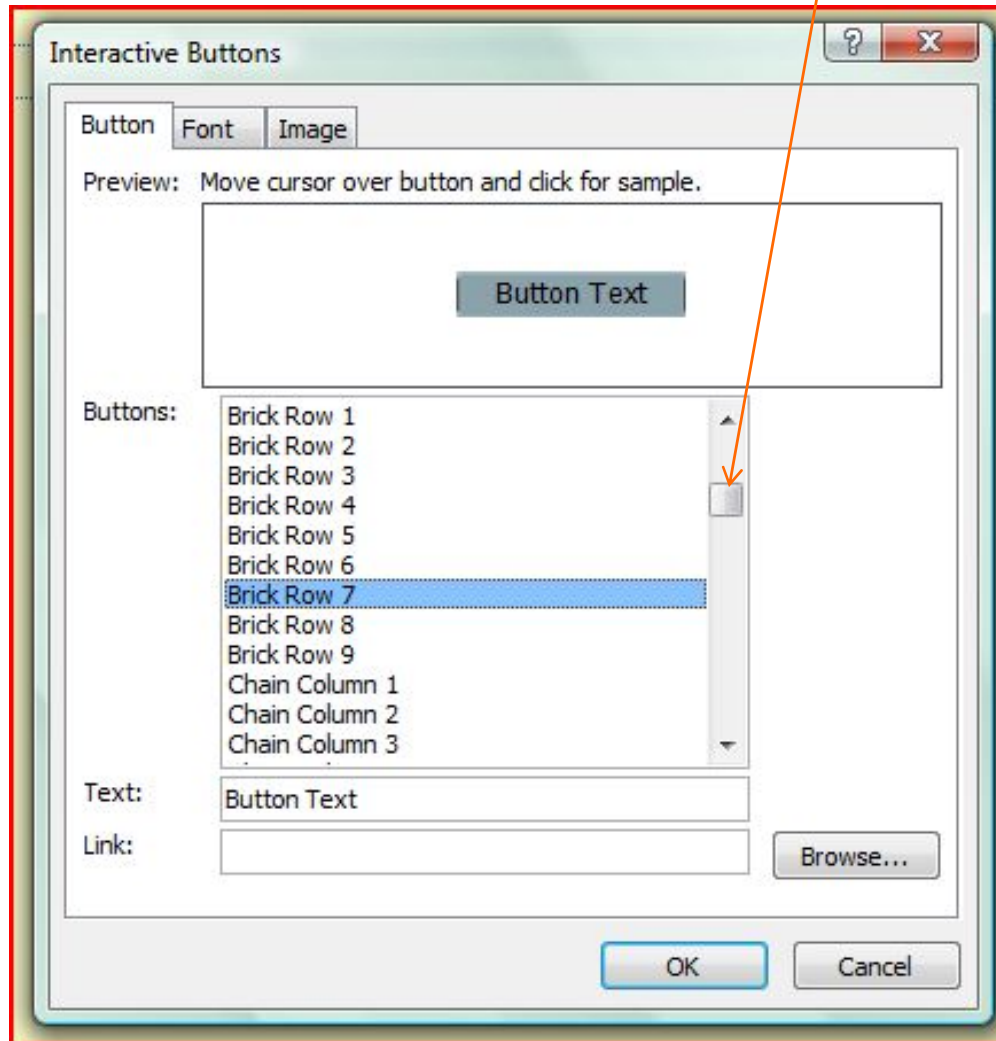

Expression Web 2 – Using Interactive Buttons

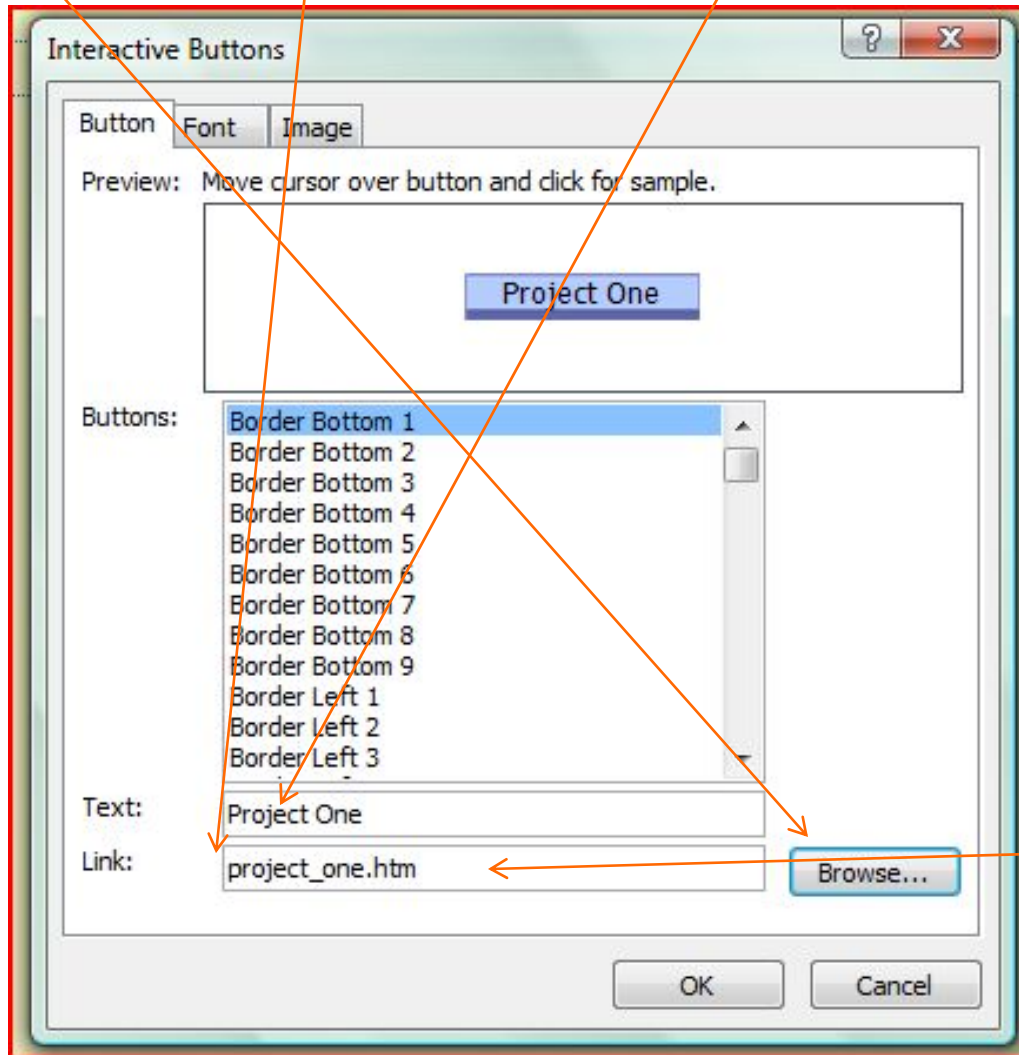
PLACE THE CURSOR WHERE YOU WANT
THE BUTTON TO APPEAR.



CLICK “INSERT” THEN “INTERACTIVE BUTTON”
THIS WINDOW APPEARS. SCROLL DOWN AND
CHOOSE THE RIGHT BUTTON FOR YOU.



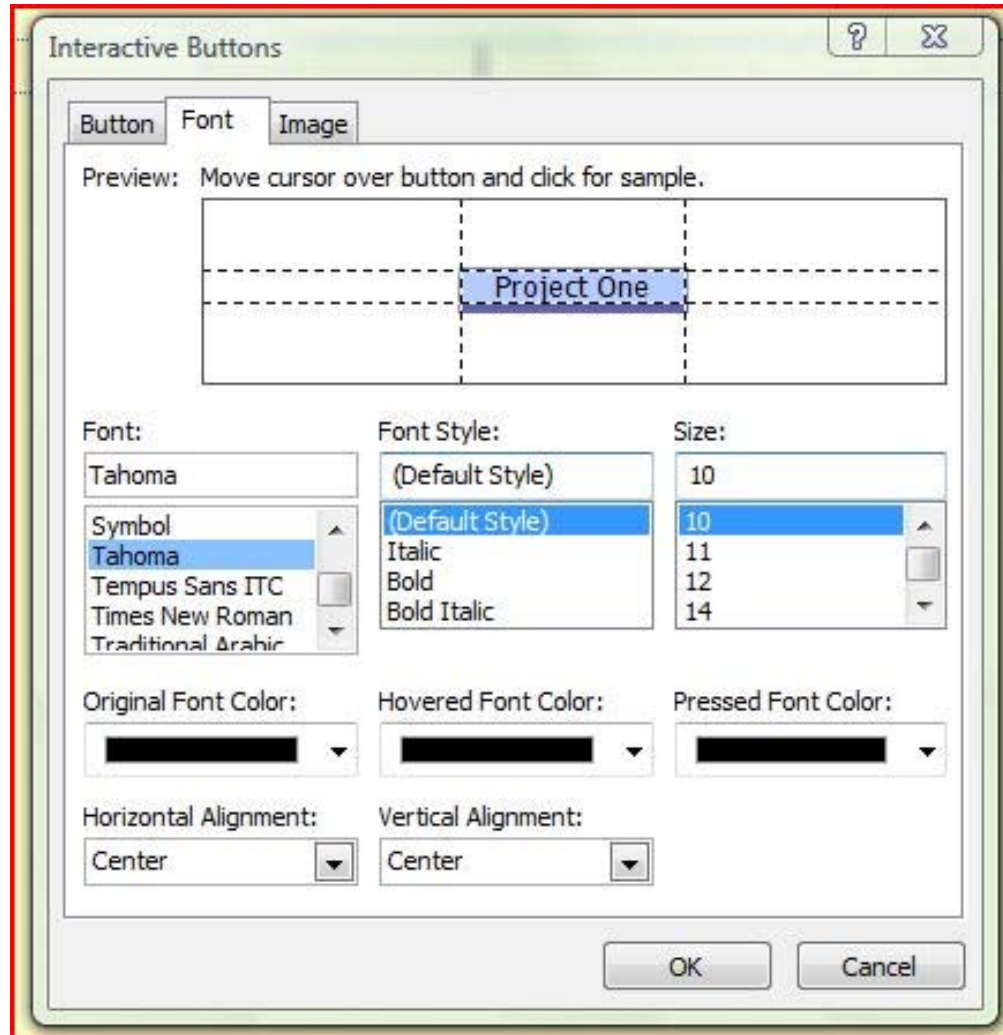
TYPE THE TITLE OF THE BUTTON UNDER “TEXT” AND THEN EITHER TYPE IN THE WEB PAGE YOU WANT IT TO LINK TO OR CLICK “BROWSE” AND SEARCH FOR YOUR DESTINATION.

NEXT CLICK THE “FONT” TAB AND EDIT YOUR BUTTON AS YOU PLEASE.



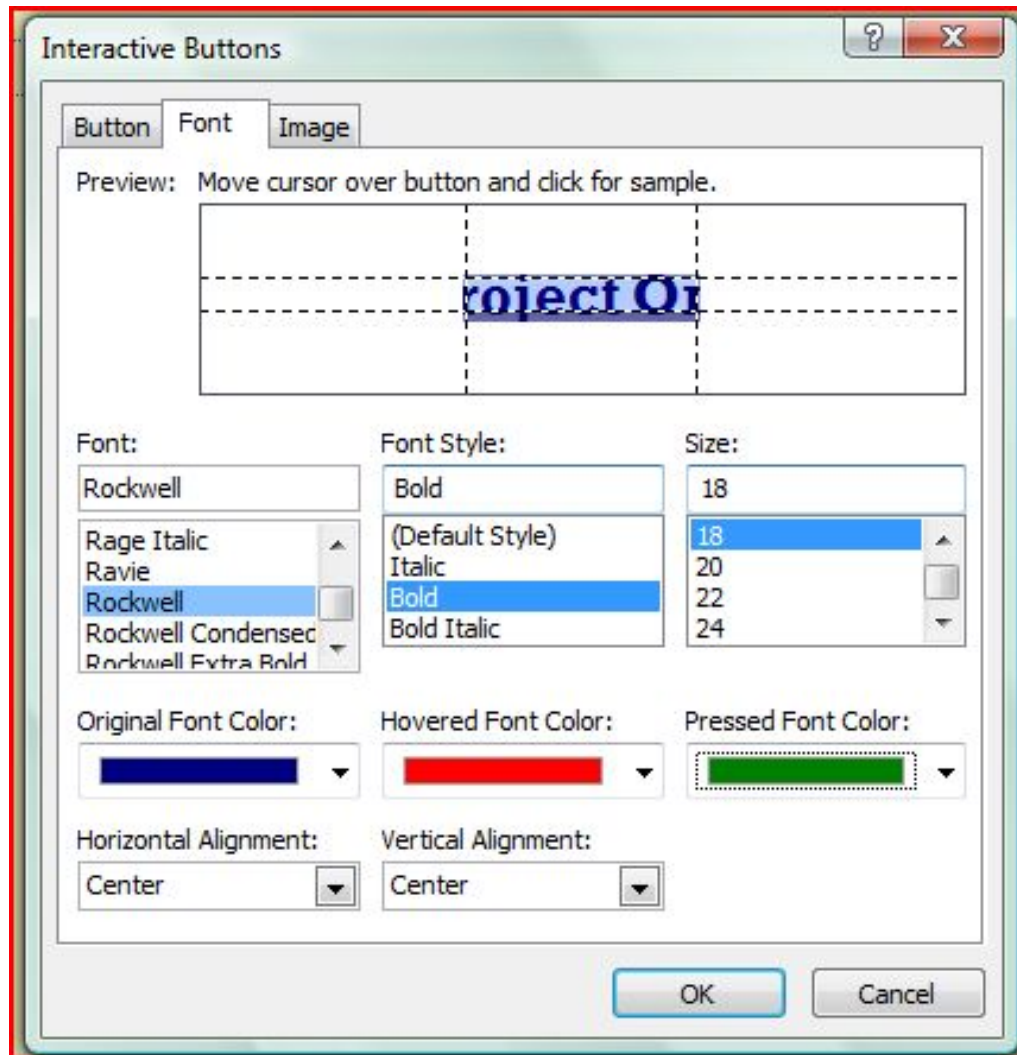
Hovered Font Color is when the mouse is on it, but not pressing it.

Pressed Font Color is when the mouse has pressed it.

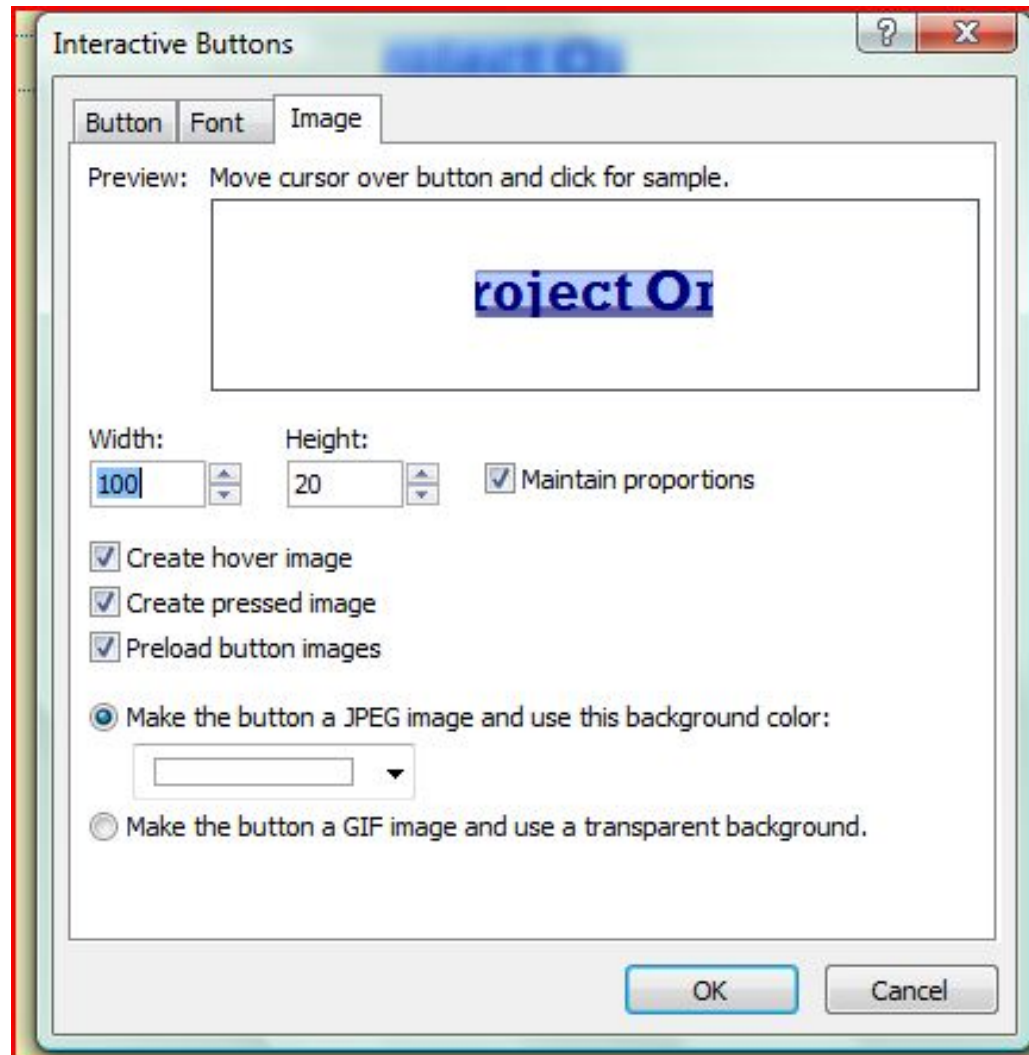


Original Font Color is what you see first.

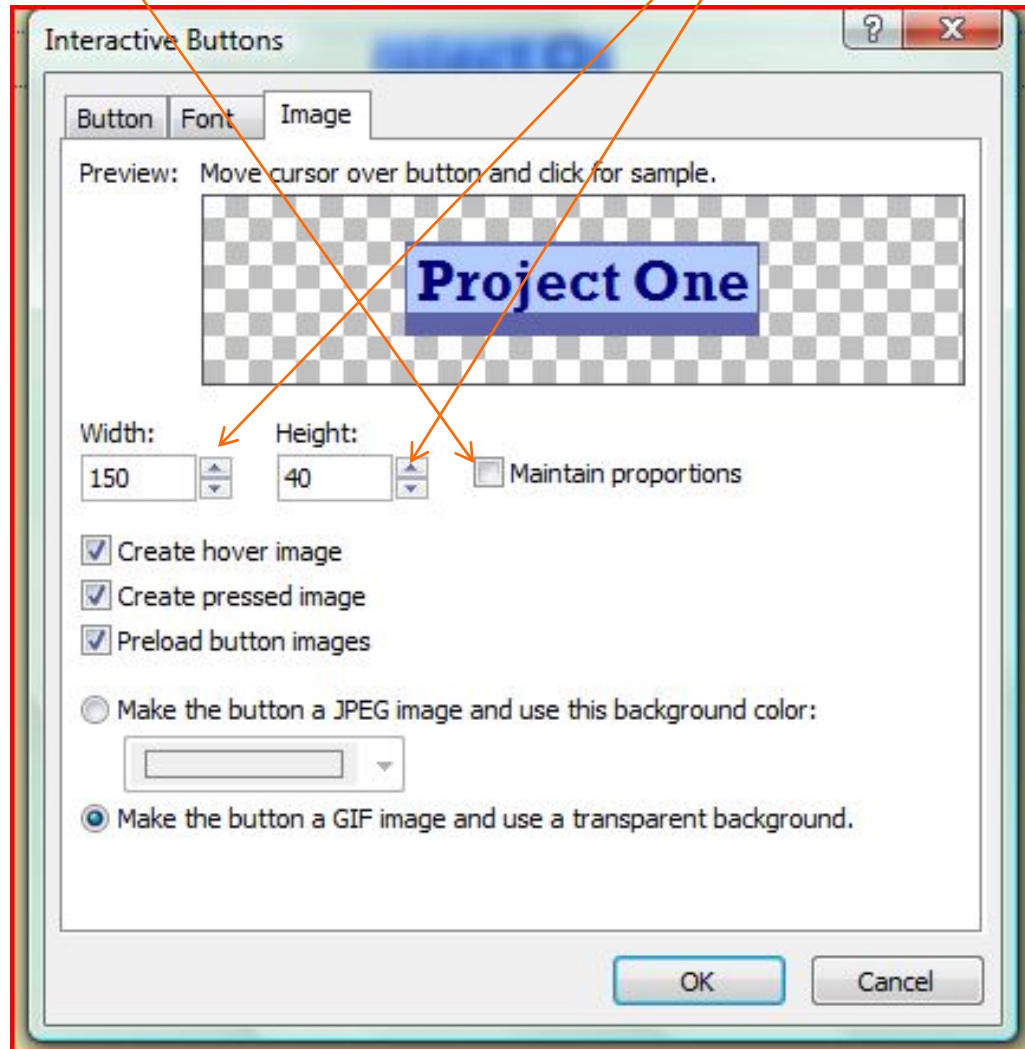
I MADE MY CHANGES TO THE FONT TYPE,
SIZE, COLORS, ETC.



CLICK THE “IMAGE” TAB AND GET THIS WINDOW. HERE’S WHERE YOU ADJUST THE SIZE AND TYPE OF IMAGE THE BUTTON SAVES AS.



MOST OF THE TIME, IT HELPS TO UNCHECK THE “MAINTAIN PROPORTIONS” BOX, THEN ADJUST THE SIZE OF THE BUTTON TO FIT THE TEXT OF THE TITLE.



I usually use the “Make the button a GIF...” because it doesn’t interfere with the page it’s on.

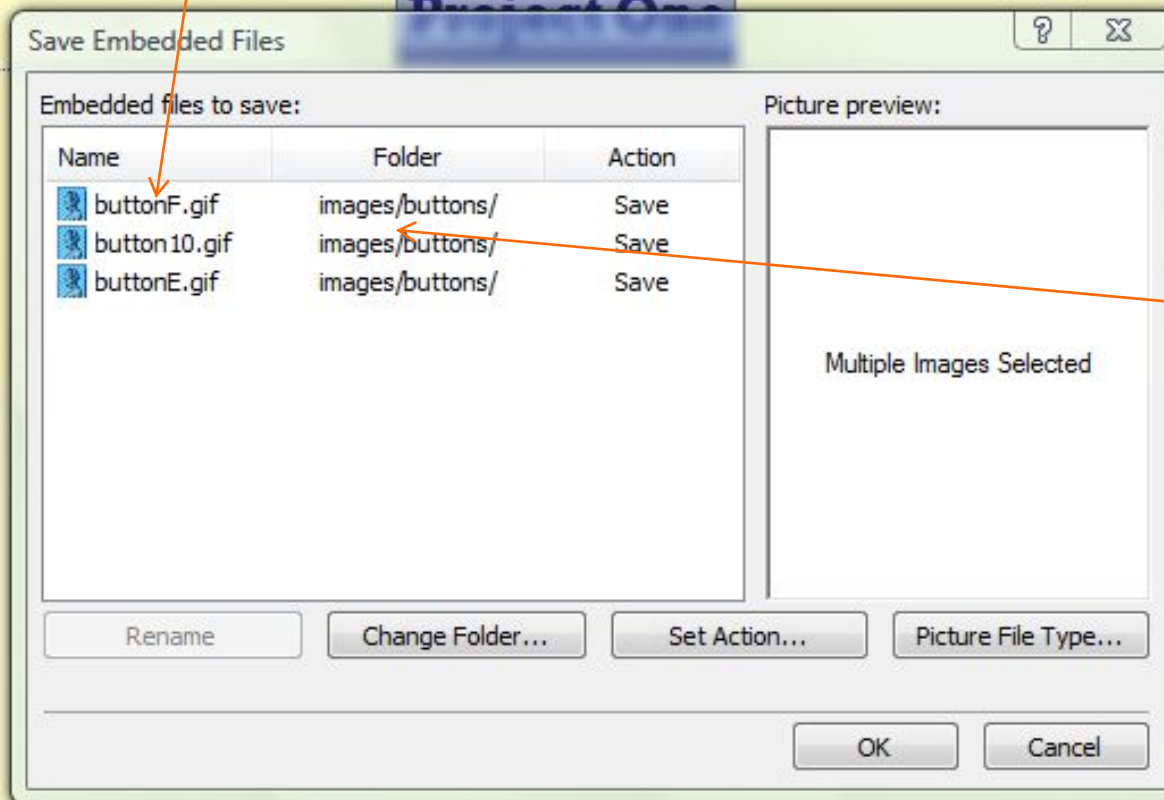
The “Create...” boxes indicate the different images that will be saved.



AFTER YOU ARE FINISHED EDITING, CLICK “OK” THEN IT ASKS YOU TO SAVE THE THREE IMAGES USED FOR THE BUTTON (HOVERED, PRESSED, PRELOADED). YOU SHOULD RENAME THESE IMAGES AND FILE THEM IN A FOLDER ON YOUR SITE.

Project One

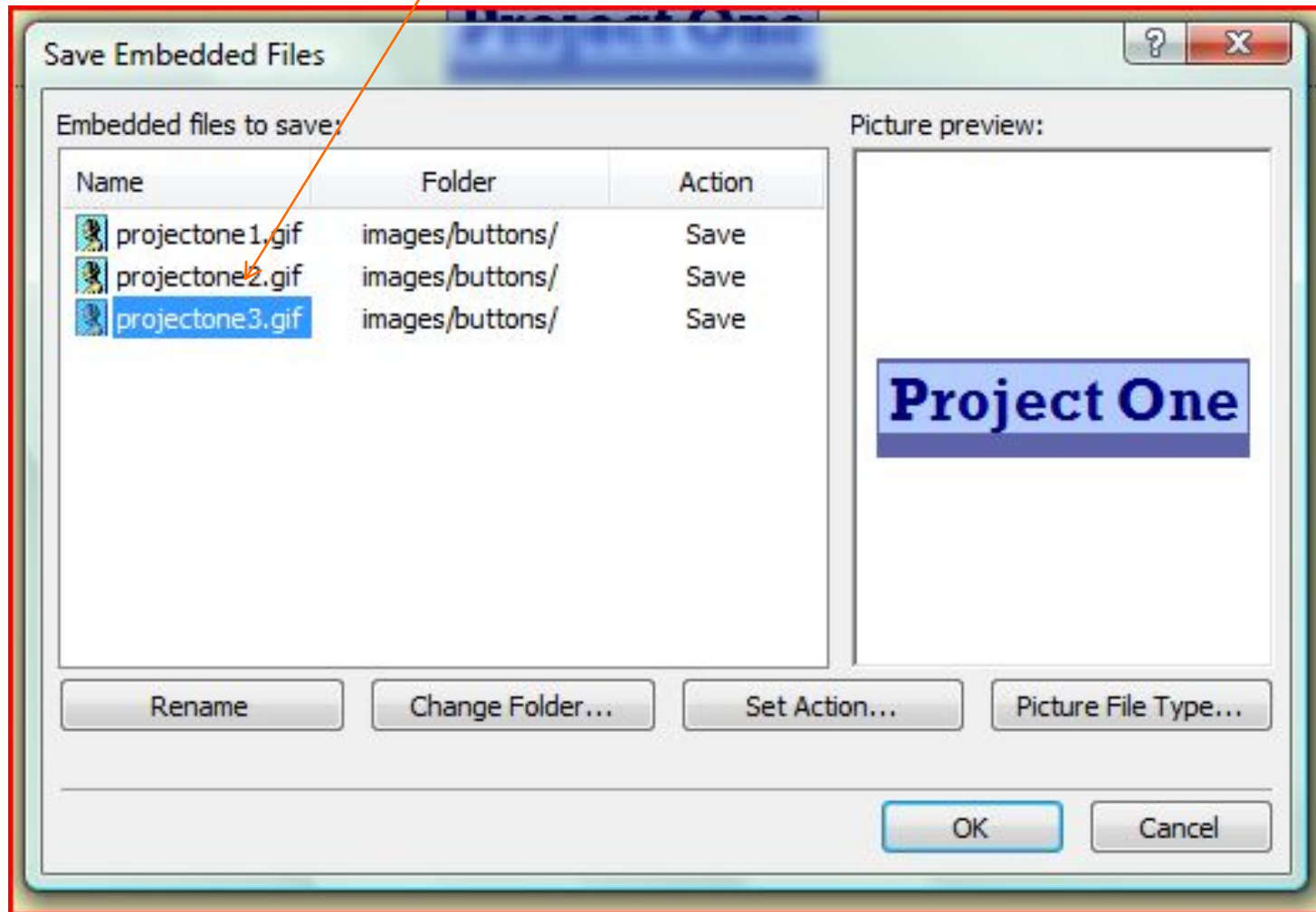


You can create your own folder. I created a “buttons” folder in my “images” folder.

You can click “Change Folder” to organize your files.



IF YOU CLICK ON THE IMAGE FILES, YOU CAN RENAME THEM. IF YOU DON'T RENAME THEM, OTHER BUTTONS YOU USE WILL TRY TO OVERWRITE THE PRE-EXISTING ONES...A MESS. JUST RENAME THEM.



YOU CAN SEE WHERE THE IMAGE FILES SAVED IN THE FOLDER LIST. ADD MORE BUTTONS AS NEEDED AND FOLLOW THE SAME STEPS.
