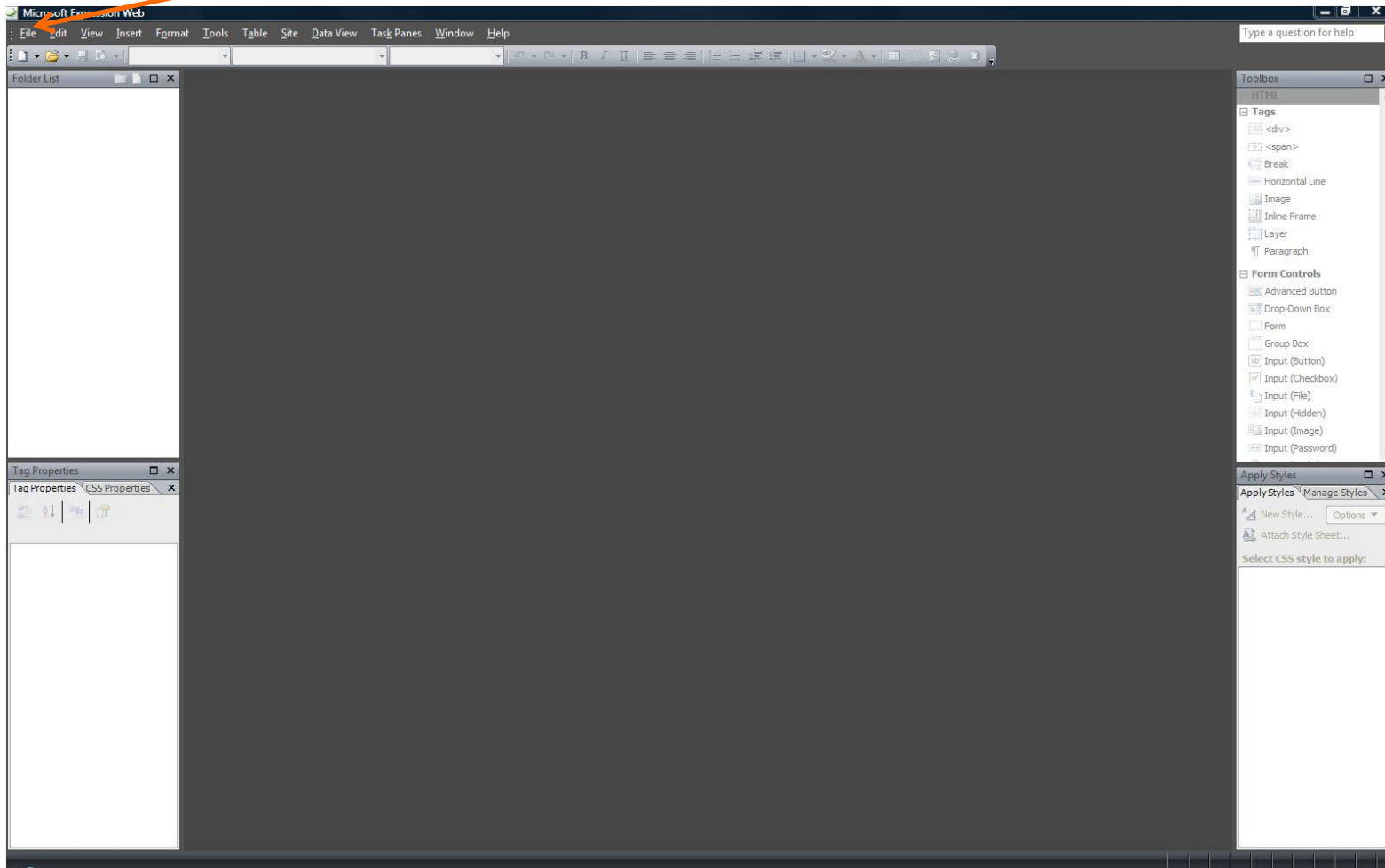


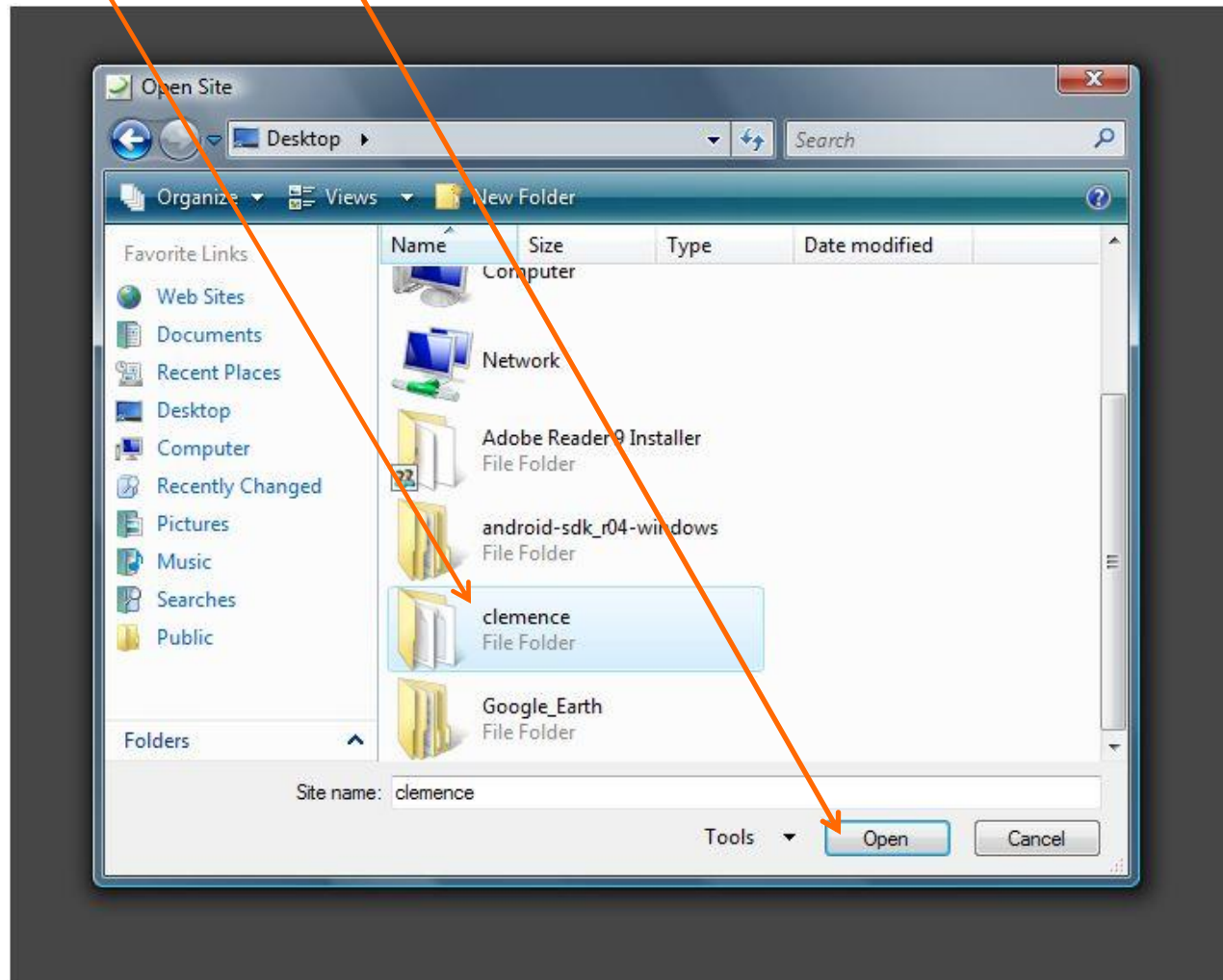

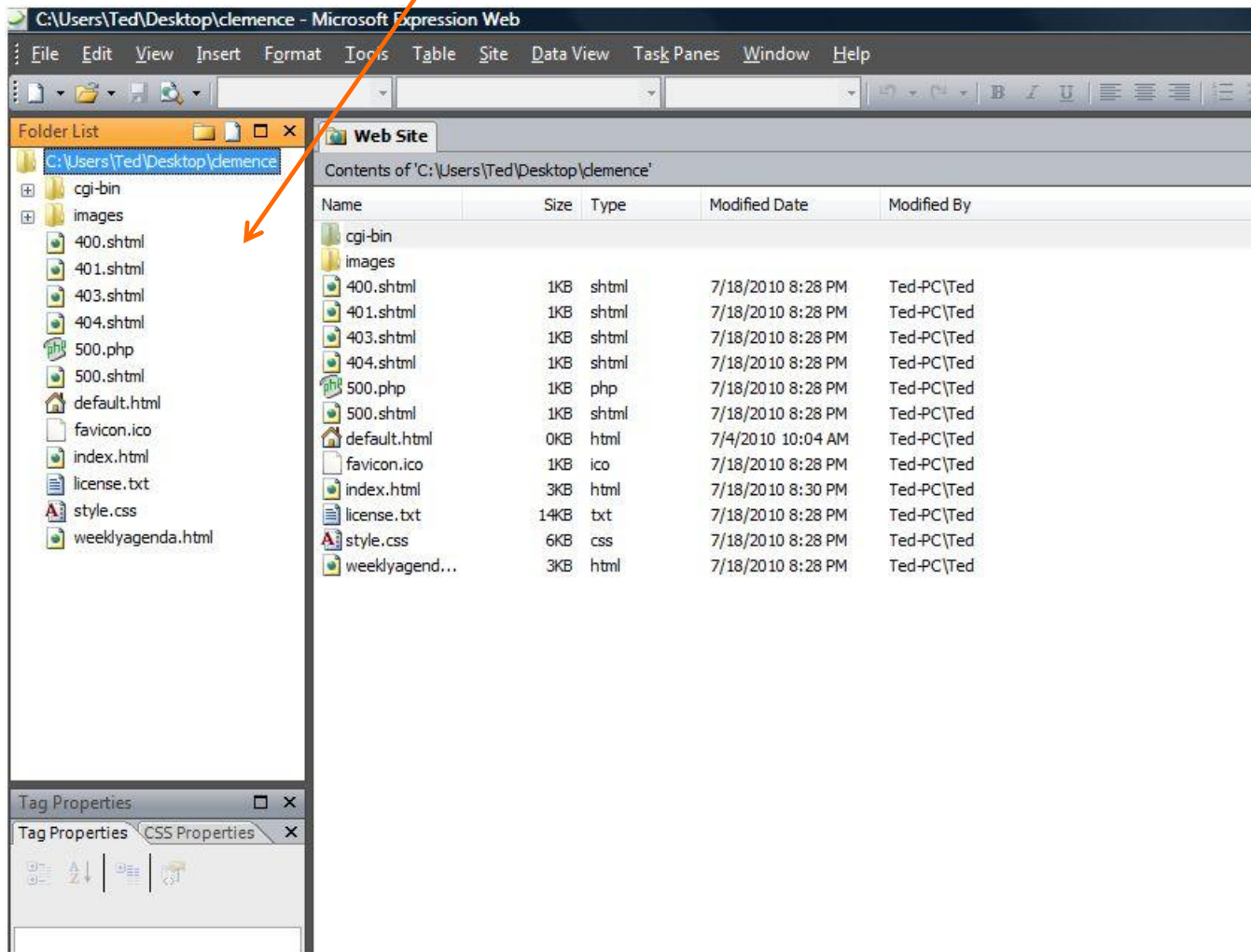
OPEN EXPRESSION WEB. THEN CLICK “FILE”

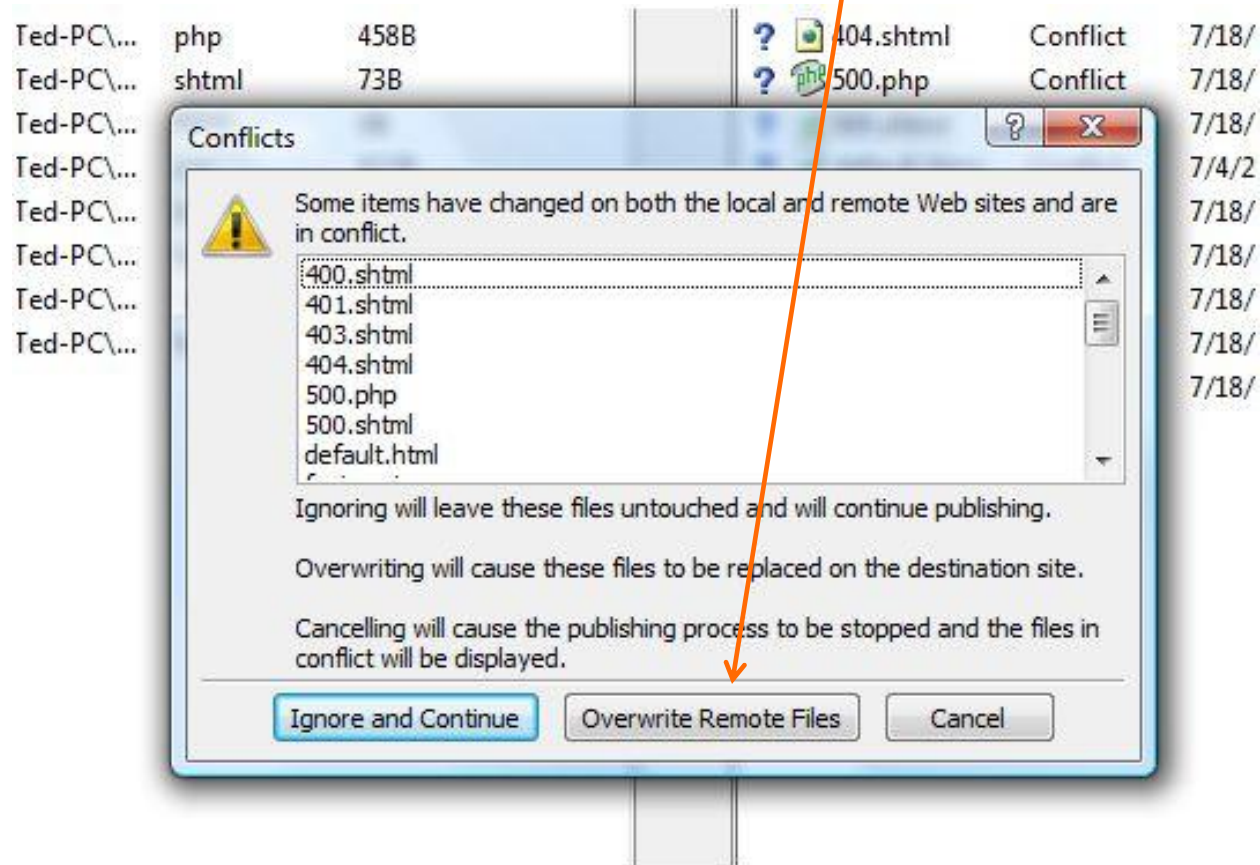
