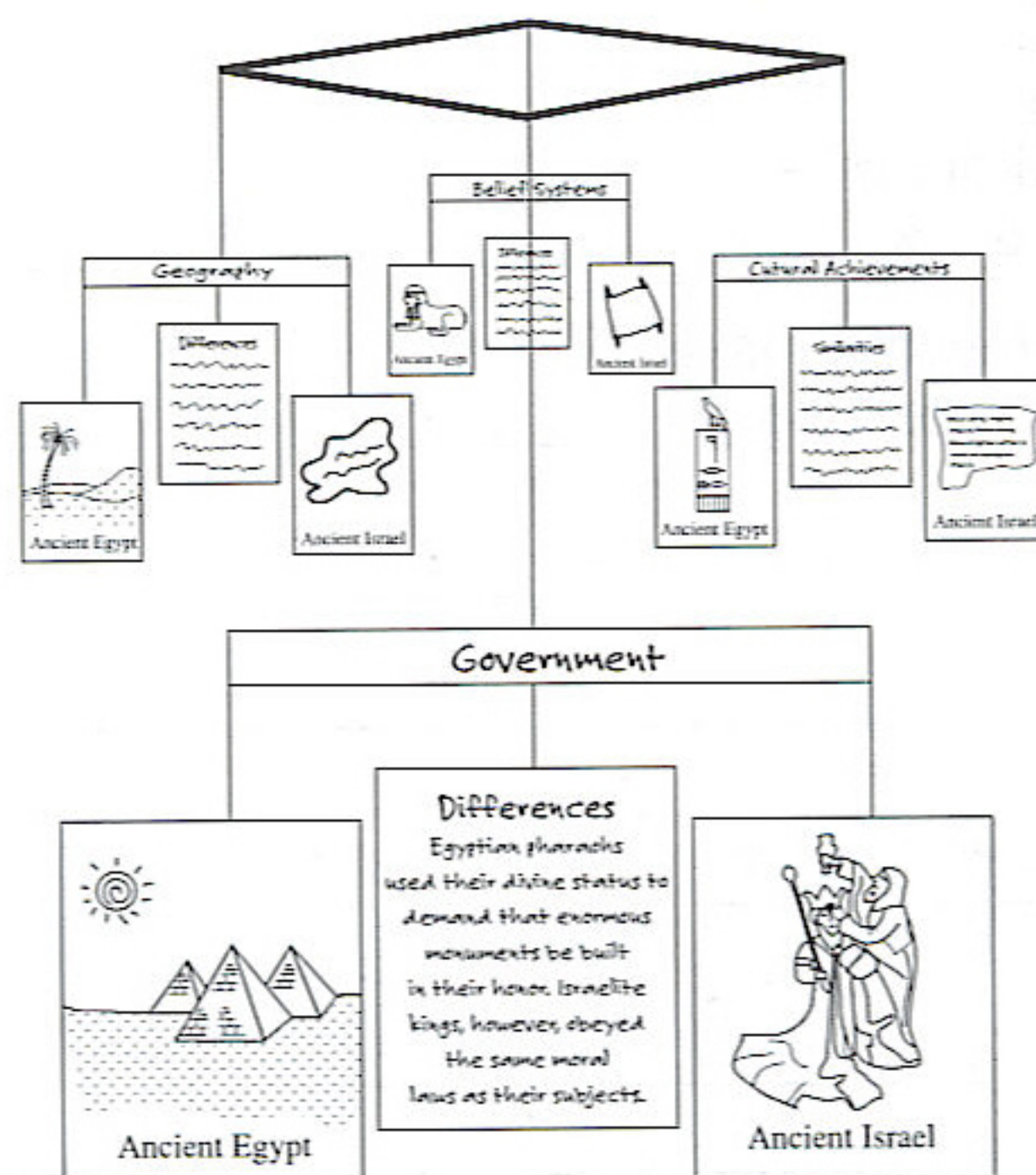


## Steps for Completing Your Mobile

1. Brainstorm ideas for your mobile by completing **CP Student Handout D: Brainstorming Ideas for a Mobile**. Use your notes from the unit to describe the similarities and differences between the two civilizations you are comparing. Then, quickly sketch the visuals you might use to illustrate your ideas. Review your ideas and sketches with your teacher before you begin creating your mobile.
2. Before creating your mobile, use **CP Student Handout E: Layout for a Mobile** to make the cards that will hang from the mobile. Copy the layout shown on **CP Student Handout E** onto separate sheets of cardstock or thick paper. Then, cut out the cards for your mobile.
3. Create your mobile. Add touches to make the cards on the mobile artistic and visually appealing, such as using extra color, writing captions with calligraphy pens, and creating extra visuals.
4. Assemble your mobile. Tape together four straws to make a rectangular frame. (**Note:** Straws can be inserted into each other if the end of one straw has been slightly cut.) With string, attach your completed cards to the rectangular frame so that the topic cards hang from the frame and the cards describing similarities and differences hang below the corresponding topic card.
